The roof of the 1921 building has been deteriorating and over the past year, every rainfall meant that buckets needed to be placed out in the hallway of the museum to catch the water falling from leaks in the ceiling. The grant has enabled the Onoway and District Historical Guild to replace the shingles on the museum roof. After that major upgrade, the corroded and lifting tiles on the floor of the museum hallway were replaced with laminate flooring.

This makes it smoother sailing for museum visitors using wheelchairs and walkers and is more reminiscent of the original wooden flooring of the building.

The new roof means that there is no longer a risk that the valued artifacts on display on the main floor of the museum will be water-damaged or that the humidity level could be risky for some artifacts.

President Hazel Bourke thanked Minister Carlier for this very welcome gift – the collection is safe once again!

# NATIONAL ADDICTION AWARENESS WEEK

National Addiction Awareness Week (NAAW) is a national week (November 12-18) recognized by Canadians across the country. Every year Albertans participate in NAAW in their local communities with the goal of providing information and promoting activities that increase the awareness of substance use problems and the range of services available in the province - including information, prevention and treatment services.

NAAW is also a week to celebrate and recognize the capacity of our communities and individuals who work together every year to support and encourage addiction-free lifestyles.

This year, the theme is Words Matter, and focuses on how the use of stigmatizing language can perpetuate false and harmful myths around substance use, and act as a barrier to recovery.

To help individuals, community groups, schools and businesses across the province in hopes of re-

ducing addictions, AHS has created an online Addiction Prevention Toolkit. To view the toolkit visit: <http://www.albertahealthservices.ca/info/Page14610.aspx>.

The toolkit includes tips for building healthy relationships and positive behaviours for individuals, parents, communities, families, schools, and workplaces.

Here are some small actions you can take to make a big difference

- Know the facts. Educate yourself about substance use problems— what can bring them on, who is more likely to develop problems, and how to prevent or reduce the severity of problems.

- Be aware of your attitudes and behavior. See people as unique human beings, not as labels or stereotypes.

- Choose your words carefully. Use accurate and sensitive words when talking about people with substance use problems. For example, speak about “people with substance use disorders” rather than an “addicts”.

- Educate others. Challenge myths and stereotypes.

- Focus on the positive. People


with substance use problems make valuable contributions to society. Their health problems don't define them or their worth.

- Support people. Treat people who have substance use problems with dignity and respect.

- Include everyone. People with substance use problems have a right

to take an equal part in society.

# PARLIAMENT UPDATE – WEEK OF NOVEMBER 6, 2017

This was a short week in Parliament. We discussed topics including the Firearms Act, the environment, government finances, and the legalization of marijuana.

The House of Commons debated the following:

- Bill S-236 – Recognition of Charlottetown as the Birthplace of Confederation Act (Referred to Committee)
  - Bill C-63 – Budget Implementation Act, 2017, No. 2 (Second Reading)
  - Bill C-346 – An Act to amend the Firearms Act (licences) (Defeated at Second Reading)
  - Bill C-17 – An Act to amend the Yukon Environmental and Socio-economic Assessment Act and to make a consequential amendment to another Act (Third Reading)
  - Bill C-45 – Cannabis Act (Report Stage)
  - Motion No. 124 – Automated external defibrillators

In the Standing Committee on Industry, Science and Technology (INDU), we continued to hear witnesses for a study on Canada's anti-spam laws. We also resumed the consideration of a draft report on intellectual property transfer. This week, I attended 12 meetings six events as well as recorded a radio message. The House has been adjourned for Friday so that MPs can travel back to their ridings in order to participate in Remembrance Day ceremonies. On Saturday, I will be attending a Remembrance Day ceremony in Drayton Valley followed by a Remembrance Day supper at the Edson Legion. Look for my update next Friday on my travels throughout the riding.

# LETTER TO THE EDITOR RE: COUNTY 'EXPERIMENT'

Perleese... tell me that we are not going down this road again – wasting more money!!

The new council hadn't even been sworn in, but they'll have to sort out the mess, because someone in the County Office thought that it would be a great idea to conduct an "experiment" and test the use of road grindings from Hwy 37 as an alternative topping in the sub-divisions just as the forecast for Fall/Winter weather – snow?? Rain?? Cold temperatures??... sound familiar for late October?? So... in Sturgeon Heights, where they'd finally got around to filling the pot holes, they ground up a perfectly good asphalt road; reshaped it; rolled it and then (after it had rained and turned it into a mud bath) finally topped it with grindings. It took a grinder, a grader, a roller, someone to put up warning signs and a flag person and a roller (and a two man and track skid-steer (contract) crew to tidy up the residence entrances) to lay the grindings. As the cost for a grader is close to \$200 per HOUR, I dread to think what this "experiment" has cost us... the taxpayers. Trying to find out what was happening, I spoke to three different people with the County and got three different answers – one said it's to replace regular gravel (why they'd rip up an asphalt road and replace it with gravel is beyond me – but whatever); another told me it still had to be heated, (after it was laid??? You'll never heat through 10" of material that's been compacted with a roller) and traffic would 'roll in down'; the third told me well have to add oil, mix it up and re-roll it.

It took me just 2 (TWO) phone calls to find out that it needs to be heated, or have solvent or tar added (BEFORE IT'S LAID!!!). So now what's the plan? When they first laid the asphalt it was only on the main loop, so they didn't plough the side roads because they were still gravel, and little kids were having to walk to the school bus through a foot of snow. Is that the plan for the rest of the subdivision this time

around??

The County has spent time and money trying to get people to 'beautify' their property (and the county) in order to attract new comers, and now a large part of this 'experiment' is going to be dumped into the ditches (preventing people from mowing them) if the roads are cleared during the winter.

I don't claim to know every-

thing, but I'm an old f...rt who's been around a long time, and it seems to me that, if you can't build sand castles from dry sand, it's a safe bet that you can't build solid road surfaces from material that's as dry as dust. Just saying!

So what have we learned from the 'experiment' in Sturgeon Heights? Using the material in the way that the County has done will give you the longest

washboards you've ever seen!! So now, who authorized this experiment?

Oh yes, the 'experiment' wasn't just done here, they tried it in several sub-divisions! It's probably politically incorrect to say that the lunatics appear to be running the asylum...

# COMMEMORATING THE 150TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE FIRST SITTING OF PARLIAMENT

On November 6th our Conservative leader, the Honourable Andrew Scheer, gave a speech in the House of Commons, commemorating the 150th Anniversary of the first sitting of Parliament. His speech made me more proud to be a Canadian and even prouder to be your representative in Yellowhead. We are fortunate to live in this great country, Canada.

This is a time of giving and remembering what we have.

I encourage everyone to read his speech.

“Mr. Speaker, for 150 years, our Parliament has been a reflection of Canada and Canadians. It is more than a building. It is the embodiment of our national character, its virtues and vices, its strengths and its weaknesses.

It has been burned to the ground and been built back up stone by stone. It has heard the echoes of gun-

fire, and felt the blast of a bomb that, thankfully, detonated mere minutes prematurely.

It has rung with cheers of victory at the end of two world wars, and it has stood mute witness to the tears of a nation mourning distinguished former members of this House lying in state, from Sir John A. Macdonald to the hon. Jack Layton.

The legislative measures debated and passed in this chamber help Canada progress and, unfortunately, they also sometimes set us back. Our

House has seen legislative measures that support our liberties and others that limit them.

This is a physical place, but also an institution, and as an institution made of human beings, the outcomes are not always perfect.

As Canadians, we must not forget our past. We must never be afraid to admit when we have made a mistake and to apologize when necessary.

That is why Prime Minister Harper came to the House nine years ago and issued a formal apology to former victims of the Indian residential schools on behalf of a country that had failed them. It was appropriate, because so many of the decisions that caused so much grief and suffering had been deliberated and, in some cases, approved right here in this building.

That we who have been trusted with the governance of Canada have sometimes failed should not be surprising. This chamber may be made of wood and stone, but the men and women who give it its life are hewn from the crooked timber of humanity. These chairs have supported patriots and heroes, but also a few rogues, so we cannot claim to have always been perfect, but we know that perfection is not available to us this side of eternity. Yet, somehow, the motley and imperfect assemblages that have gathered here over the last 150 years have achieved something of a miracle.

Together, the members who came before us superintended a Canada that has grown and flourished beyond what anyone in the first Parliament could have dreamed.

It is fashionable today to look down at the past, but that is a luxury we enjoy from heights built by those who preceded us in this chamber. If we look back at our rich history and study the leading figures in its telling and see only the blemishes, then we are missing out on the beautiful story of a country constantly bettering itself, and consistently offering a refuge to so many around the world. It is a story of different parliaments at

different times, working through the imperfections of the day. It is a story that on the whole has been a story of hope for so many. It is a story of prosperity, compassion, liberty, and human rights.

To those who deny we have anything to be proud of as a country, I would pose a simple question: "Where else would you have rather lived for the last 150 years?" That is not a rhetorical question. It is a straightforward question for which there is only one honest answer. There is nowhere we would rather have lived, no country we would rather call our home, for no country has acquitted herself better at home and abroad than Canada.

It is indisputable that the world has been better off for the last 150 years because of Canada. Without the sacrifices of our soldiers, sailors, and airmen, more than 100,000 of whom paid the ultimate sacrifice, while many more came home bearing scars, mental and physical, the world would be more dangerous.

Without the brilliance of our artists, painters, sculptors, writers, singers, and actors, the world would be losing part of its cultural richness.

Without the work of the men and women who cultivate, farm, and develop our incredible landscape, who fish in our three great oceans that surround us, and who work in the towns, plants, and office towers, the world would be poorer, colder, and darker. If we dwell on past mistakes, we miss out on their remarkable successes. We end up taking for granted their contribution to Canada and Canada's contribution to the rest of the world.

It is time for a little gratitude. Make that a lot of gratitude.

That we have prospered and flourished is no accident. It is a combination of good fortune and good stewardship. We are fortunate to have inherited the most stable and enduring political system in the world. We should be grateful to the members of the House who have nurtured and sustained it for the benefit of Canadians and the inspiration of the world.

For it is to this House that world leaders have come over the last century to express their admiration of Canada as the very exemplar of peace, order, and good government. It was here that Churchill came in Britain's darkest hour, when Hitler's armies were within sight of English shores, to thank Canada for our support and to display his jowl-shaking defiance in the face of Nazi aggres-

sion.

Later, we were engaged in a very different kind of war against Soviet imperialism, a battle not just based on geography but on ideology, a battle to defend the economic freedom that had created untold prosperity for so many millions around the world, yet a freedom that was denied to so many. During that battle, two of the great figures of the 20th century, Ronald Reagan and Margaret Thatcher, each came to this House twice to thank Canada for our friendship and dedication to key principles.

More recently, Ukrainian President Petro Poroshenko came to Canada while his country was suffering under a new Russian imperialism, to praise "the special partnership between Ukraine and Canada" and to salute Canada as a model for Ukraine and for the world.

It is in our nature as Canadians to be self-deprecating, but sometimes, maybe once every 150 years, it is okay to acknowledge what the rest of the world tells us: we occupy a special place in the fellowship of free nations and our institutions, includ-

ing this Parliament, are the envy of other nations.

I am not asking members of the House to pat ourselves on the back and congratulate ourselves for assuming this awesome duty. Rather, let us roll up our sleeves and get to work in the House and across Canada to continue the work of those who came before us so that those who come after us, 150 years from now, will consider us worthy of the same gratitude we offer today to our predecessors."

# LAC STE. ANNE COUNTY PRESENTS A FREE CLUBROOT INFORMATION SESSION!

**Submitted by Stacy Berry, Assistant Agricultural Services Manager | Lac Ste. Anne County**

Clubroot is a soil-borne pathogen of cruciferous plants. It was first discovered in Alberta in 2007, and has been spreading like a wildfire since. Given that our last two summers have been very wet, the number of confirmed cases across the county has spiked significantly; over the last six years, 30% of our cases

were confirmed in 2017 alone. Unlike werewolves, clubroot is not a myth and there is no silver bullet that will fix a clubroot problem. Lac Ste. Anne County is hosting an information session on November 21, 2017, from 9:00 am to 12:30 pm, at the Lac Ste. Anne County Office (56521 Rge Rd 65), to provide producers with information on how to prevent and manage clubroot issues; a detailed walkthrough

of the pathogen's lifecycle; and provincial and county policy towards clubroot. We have three great speakers coming in, Dr. Stephen Strelkov, PhD., from the University of Alberta; Dan Orchard, with the Canola Council of Canada; and Dr. Michael Harding, PhD., with the Crop Diversification Centre South. These are professionals in the industry, all of whom have been studying this disease for

years. If you want to know everything you can about clubroot, these men are the ones to speak with. Anyone who wants to learn more about the pathogen that causes clubroot and its effects is invited to attend this free information session.
