# ONOWAY SAYS GOODBYE TO ROCK VICTORY CHURCH

As 2017 wound down, excitement was in the air as people in Onoway looked forward to a new year and new challenges. But it was not all happy times.

One hundred and fifty people gathered at the Alliance Activity Centre on December 31 to say goodbye to Pastor Bernie and Pastor Kelly Riopel and the Rock Victory Church. The theme that day was "A new door cannot be opened until you have the courage to close the one behind". After almost 16 years of meeting the spiritual needs of

their congregation and providing programs to the community as a whole, Pastors Kelly and Bernie, due to health issues, felt they were no longer able to minister in Onoway. And so, sadly, an era came to an end.

The Rock Victory Church held its first church service on March 9, 2002 with 86 in attendance. For the first two years, they operated out of the Bethel United Church. In January 2004, the Church moved to the Amazing Millions building across from the Jade Restaurant on 50th Street; this they called home for four years. In 2008, the Rock moved to the Patriot Crossing

building on Lac Ste. Anne Trail. Their final move came in 2012 when they moved into the Onoway Heritage Centre.

A questionnaire from the church to all Onoway residents in 2002 asked two questions:

- 1. What is lacking in Onoway in terms of activities?
- 2. What are your spiritual needs?

Responses to question 1 suggested a lack of activities for young people and those not so young.

# STRUCTURE FIRE IN THE SUMMER VILLAGE OF SUNSET POINT

At 1013 Friday January 12, 2017 North West Fire Rescue – Onoway – Canada's first Hybrid Fire Service was paged out to a confirmed structure fire – unknown injuries – unknown entrapment on 48A Avenue, Sunset Point. North West Fire Rescue had units rolling within one-minute of the call with the first unit arriving on scene approximately seven-minutes of the initial page out.

Upon their arrival, fire crews observed large volumes of smoke emanating from the home. Crews quickly forced entry, completed a search, and located the origin of the fire. Thankfully the home was not occupied at the time and no injuries occurred. Due to the hard work and dedication of the men and women of the fire department, the fire was contained to one room. At the peak of the incident, North West Fire Rescue -Onoway deployed for units and sixteen firefighters.

Responses to question 2 suggested that those not belonging to a church were not invited to join churches that were already in operation.

Over the years, the Rock Victory Church held meetings and programs for youth, men and women. Financial speakers, marriage workshops, community children's programs, X-treme Youth Group with 35 to 100 kids each night, ladies spa night, Saturday floor hockey at the Alliance Activity Centre - all were well attended. The children's party featuring games, crafts and activities was well received. The VBS week-long camp in July was always fully registered. In 2017, 150 kids and 65 volunteers attended daily. In 2008 the Church held its first "Take the Plunge" Vacation Bible School; 68 kids attended and six bicycles were given away. Building relationships with youth was a major focus from day one.

Pastors Kelly and Bernie Riopel moved to Onoway in March 2001 as newly-weds. Bernie was raised in Edmonton, Kelly in southern Alberta. Kelly was an associate pastor with Victory Church on the Rock when she met and married Bernie. They told God they would go anywhere he asked them to go and Onoway was so very fortunate he brought them here.

The Rock Victory Church was a part of Victory Churches International, an Alberta -born denomination under the leadership of Drs. George and Hazel Hill. The movement began in 1979 with the planting and pastoring their first church in Lethbridge.

We thank Pastors Bernie and Kelly for their 16 years of service to Onoway. They will be sorely missed - we wish them well!

# WHITECOURT TOWN COUNCIL UPDATE

The Town of Whitecourt is hosting a 2018 Budget Open House on Wednesday, February 28 from 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. at the Allan & Jean Millar Centre. The event, which is in its third year, will provide information to the public on the interim budget, provide opportunity for ratepayers to comment, and allow for two-way communication between the public and Whitecourt representatives. Residents are encouraged to attend and share their thoughts. Watch for advertisements in the coming weeks!

The Whitecourt Children's Festival will no longer be hosted annually, and the next event is scheduled for May 2019. The decision to move the event to a biannual format was made due to lower registration from local

and surrounding schools. Based on feedback from schools, most can only afford to participate in one large field trip per year, and many enjoy varying the trips.

Whitecourt is applying to the Alberta Community Partnership grant program for support of the Regional Business Park Feasibility Study in partnership with Woodlands County. If approved, the study would provide both communities essential information necessary to meet the needs of current and future industry in the area. The study would also provide direction in regards to possible locations for a future business park, identify gaps within current industry providers, and outline needs and potential partnerships to help grow, diversify and sustain local business.

The next Regular Meeting of Council is scheduled for Tuesday, January 23 at 7:00 p.m. at the Forest Interpretive Centre.

# CHANGES MADE TO THE CANADA SUMMER JOBS PROGRAM FOR 2018

I have serious concerns over an issue that has recently come to light regarding the Canada Summer Jobs Program (CSJ). For years, the CSJ Program has provided funding to employers across Canada to hire young Canadians for summer job placements. Students benefit by gaining valuable employment and work experience, and communities benefit from the important services provided by these organizations. This has always been done in a non-partisan fashion.

I have learned that the Liberals have tried to quietly, without any consultation with Members of Parliament or Canadian employers, change the process through which employers apply for funding through the CSJ Program. The Government is now requiring those who apply for funding to sign the form that the employer agrees to uphold certain "values"—values that align with the Liberal Party's own ideology. This is unacceptable and, I would argue, is inconsistent with the Canadian Charter of Rights and Freedoms. This is

and Canadians should be extremely skeptical of a government that is basing funding decisions on whether or not you hold the same beliefs and values as they do.

There are numerous churches and religiously motivated organizations that receive annual funding through the CSJ Program and have received this funding for years. Typically, these funds are used to run summer camps and programs. Many young people who work at these programs gain valuable work experience over the course of the summer.

for any unlawful purpose as this Government seems to suggest. This new requirement would leave these institutions two choices. Choice #1 would be to sign the form against their own beliefs and religion — which for most is not an option. Choice #2 would be to lose the funding and cancel their programs. Religious institutions should never be treated this way by their own Government.

The Charter of Rights and Freedoms explicitly protects the freedom of conscience and religion, freedom of belief, freedom of expression, and freedom of opinion. To punish employers applying for non-partisan funding simply because they have different views and ideology than the Government of the day is unacceptable.

If the Prime Minister were to apply this same process to eligibility for Old Age Security (OAS), I am sure that there would be a number of seniors that would either be forced to lie on the form or be forced to live without benefits that they are entitled to.

As a diverse society, Canada allows for diverse opinions and protects those who may think differently than those in positions of power. In fact, the right to freedom of belief and opinion is guaranteed by the Charter.

If your organization is effected by this discriminatory Liberal change, I urge you to submit your application anyway with a brief note explaining that in good conscience you are unable to sign the form.

I will be pressuring the Government to remove this ridiculous requirement in the application process for the CSJ Program and will be watching closely to ensure that employers in my riding are not rejected for refusing to swear to abide by this Government's priorities

I encourage you – whether you're impacted directly or not – contact the Minister of Employment, Patricia Hajdu at Patty.Hajdu@parl. gc.ca and Prime Minister Trudeau at pm@pm.gc.ca and let them know you won't stand for these dangerous changes. 


