WHITECOURT RCMP CHARGE THREE IN DRUG TRAFFICKING INVESTIGATION

Whitecourt, Alberta – On May 1, 2018 the Whitecourt RCMP GIS unit with the assistance of Grande Prairie ALERT, and RCMP Police Dog Services arrested 3 individuals for drug trafficking.

During the week of April 27, 2018 a drug investigation dubbed “Operation Krashlanding” was undertaken. The investigation focused on the sale of cocaine, methamphetamine, and heroin in the Whitecourt area. Evidence gathered during this project lead to a search warrant being executed at a Whitecourt

residence where 4.2g of cocaine, 4.3g of methamphetamine, 1g of heroin, and tablets of Oxycodone and Buprenorphine were seized. A hunting knife, bear spray and an air rifle were also seized as a result of the search warrant.

SUMMER CAMPS WITH A DIFFERENCE

For some students summer camp is a great way to start the summer. Gateway Academy in conjunction with Onoway Junior Senior High School is very excited to announce Career Exposure Summer Boot Camps at our outreach facility here in Onoway.

Boot Camps will be running July

3rd to 7th. Classes run from 9 am to 3:00 pm each day. There will be no charge for students to take the courses and students enrolled in any of the offered programs can receive credits towards their high school diploma.

Successful completion of Industrial Safety Certification will give 5 credits to students. They will earn industry recognized 3-year certifications in H2S Alive, WHMIS 2015, Flagging, Transportation of Dangerous Goods, Confined Spaces,

Detection & Control of Flammables, Ground Disturbance, Fall Protection, Fire Extinguisher, and Ladder Safety.

On July 3rd and 4th, a First Aid/CPR and AED course is being offered for 1 credit. Students will learn how to save lives with first aid, CPR, AED ((Automated External Defibrillator) and resuscitation training resources from the Heart and Stroke Foundation. As with the Industrial Safety Certification, students who successfully pass this course will obtain a 3-year first aid/CPR certification.

Also being offered is X-Treme Robots for 3 credits. Enrolled students will gain a general understanding of robots and robot environment. Students will integrate robot control language to design, develop, implement and debug robotic programs. They will employ standards for structural programming constructs and simple data structures.

NEW AGRICULTURAL FUNDING PROGRAMS ANNOUNCED

OTTAWA: Jim Eglinski, Member of Parliament for Yellowhead, is pleased to make constituents aware of various funding opportunities for projects related to agriculture.

On February 13, 2018, the Government of Canada launched six federal programs under the Canadian Agricultural Partnership, which is a \$3-billion, five-year investment by federal, provincial and territorial governments to strengthen and grow Canada’s agricultural sector. It includes \$2 billion in federal, provincial and territorial cost-shared strategic initiatives, and \$1 billion for federal activities and programs.

The funding focuses on three key areas, outlined below along with the corresponding programs:

Growing Trade and Expanding Markets

1. The AgriMarketing Program is a five-year, \$121 million federal initiative to increase and diversify exports to international markets. There is a National Industry Association Component as well as a Small and Medium-sized enterprise Component.

2. The AgriCompetitiveness Program is a five-year, \$20.5 million program to assist industry-led efforts to provide producers with information needed to build capacity and support the sector’s development.

Innovative and Sustainable Growth in the Sector

3. The AgriScience Program is a five-year, \$338 million initiative to support applied science and innovation driven by industry research priorities.

4. The AgriInnovate Program is a five-year, \$128 million initiative to accelerate the demonstration, commercialization, and/or adoption of innovative agri-based products, technologies, processes or services.

Supporting Diversity and a Dynamic, Evolving Sector

5. The AgriDiversity Program

is a five-year, \$5 million initiative to help under-represented groups in Canadian agriculture, including youth, women, Indigenous Peoples, and persons with disabilities to fully participate in the sector.

6. The AgriAssurance Program is a five-year, \$74 million federal initiative to help industry develop and adopt systems, standards, and tools that enable them to make reliable and verifiable claims about the health and safety of Canadian

agricultural and agri-food products. There is a National Industry Association Component as well as a Small and Medium-sized Enterprise Component.

Because these are on-going programs, the deadline to apply is September 30, 2022, or until funding has been fully committed. The programs end March 31, 2023.

“Canadian farmers are the best in the world. They are proud stewards of the land, innovators,

and entrepreneurs. They are hard working families and communities who grow, cultivate, and process food not only for Canada, but the world. I encourage all those who qualify to take full advantage of these funding opportunities over the coming years,” concluded MP Eglinski.



THE BASICS OF MULCHING

Mulch is available in various forms. Like other land and garden products, mulch can go a long way toward helping plants thrive.

Mulch comprises just about any material that is spread over the surface of soil. Its purpose is primarily to help soil retain moisture. In addition, mulch can staunch weed growth, keep soil cool, improve the aesthetics of garden beds, and even improve soil nutrient composition. When the right mulch is chosen, it can reduce the amount of time homeowners spend watering and weeding their gardens and insulate plants from dramatic changes in weather.

Gardeners may not realize that mulch also can prevent garden soil from becoming overly compacted, according to HGTV. This can mean beneficial earthworms

can move easily through the soil, creating channels for water and depositing their nutrient-rich waste products.

Gardeners can choose organic or inorganic mulch. Organic mulches are derived from natural materials that will decompose over time, lending organic matter as well as various nutrients to the soil. Organic mulches also may contain beneficial microorganisms that can fight against plant diseases. Inorganic mulches may be made of stones, landscape fabrics and plastic. Both types will need to be amended or replaced as they degrade. Those who want the most environmentally-friendly mulching materials can choose all-natural mulches instead of synthetic alternatives.

To work effectively, mulch should be applied in a two-

three-inch layer of material, state the experts at Old World Garden Farms. This is the ideal amount to retain soil moisture and suppress weed growth without choking plants. Also, mulch that is too thick may make it impossible for water to penetrate, or it may prevent the soil from airing out, causing continuously wet conditions that lead to root and stem rot.

The University of Connecticut Home & Garden Education Center says mulch should not be placed directly against plant crowns or tree bases, as this can promote the development of disease. It may also serve as a habitat for bark- and stem-eating rodents. The center also suggests watering newly installed bark or wood mulches to prevent fungi from colonizing in dry mulch and

causing problems like a water-repellent surface on the mulch.

Home landscapers considering mulch types may find that compost, manure and grass clippings (from nonpesticide-treated lawns) can be inexpensive and versatile in garden beds. The home advice site The Spruce notes that newspaper may also be effective. Many newspapers have switched over to organic dyes, especially for their black and white sections. Newspapers are an inexpensive way to suppress weeds and act like organic mulch in beds. They can be covered with other organic mulch, like shredded bark, for more visual appeal.

Mulch can be a versatile asset when doing gardening projects around home landscapes. And the benefits are more than just aesthetic.

Succulents can be just what indoor or outdoor gardens need. Even though succulents are becoming more popular, there are still some people who are unaware of their attributes. By learning more about succulents, people may become devotees of these unique plants.




