NEW CENTRALIZED PHONE LINE TO REPORT ABUSE

If people suspect someone is being abused or neglected, they can get help by calling the Alberta Supports abuse line at 1-855-4HELPAB (4435722).

The phone line includes new staff training and protocols, such as an abuse response procedure to help ensure a coordinated provincial response to callers. All calls will be tracked to ensure Albertans receive the supports they need.

"No one should live in fear or suffer alone. This phone line means Albertans know where to turn to get the help they need. If you know or suspect someone is being abused or neglected but don't know what to do, Alberta Supports can help. This is part of our government's commitment to ensuring the safety and security of individuals who need extra care and support." - Irfan Sabir, Minister of Community and Social Services

A coordinated reporting system to address situations of abuse or neglect was one of the recommendations made in Judge Michele Collinson's report stemming from the Betty Ann Gagnon fatality inquiry.

The phone line and new protocols are designed to ensure Albertans who may be more vulnerable to abuse, such as those who rely on others for daily assistance, special care and access to government services, have the information and support they need, when they need it. Abuse can be physical, emotional, sexual or financial. This includes hitting, threatening, inappropriate touching or theft of funds

The service will be a single point of contact if Albertans are unsure of where to get help. If someone is in immediate danger or facing a significant health or safety risk, contact 911.

"This phone line will increase the protection of Alberta's most vulnerable citizens. Many agencies such as CORE Association have protocols for reporting abuse and neglect, but this direct line will be an open


and available resource to the general public when they have observed some form of neglect." - Rita Besant, executive director, CORE Association

In addition to the new phone line, Community and Social Services staff can address Albertans' questions about abuse. People with concerns can go into any Alberta Supports for assistance.

Alberta Supports helps individuals and families connect with more than

30 programs and 120 community services that address:

- seniors issues
- employment
- homelessness
- financial needs
- children and youth
- parents and families
- people with disabilities
- guardianship and trusteeship
- abuse, bullying and family violence prevention



STONY PLAIN AND SPRUCE GROVE SENIORS TO PAY LESS FOR HUNTING LICENCES THIS FALL

STONY PLAIN – Stony Plain MLA Erin Babcock and Spruce Grove-St. Albert MLA Trevor Horne are pleased with the NDP government’s move to make life more affordable for many rural

seniors. This fall, the prices for hunting licences will be reduced for Alberta seniors:

- \$8.25 for a combination wildlife certificate and bird game permit, down from \$44.02.
- \$8.25 for a white-tailed deer licence, down from \$39.95

Partner licences for senior Albertan hunters will cost \$12. The new prices will mean Alberta will have one of the lowest-cost licences in Canada for seniors to hunt game birds and white-tailed deer. The government will also be partnering with the Alberta

Hunter Education Instructors’ Association (AHEIA) to create mentorship so seniors can pass along their skills to a new generation of young Alberta hunters. “I want seniors to know that I’m standing up for them. For seniors living on fixed incomes, the cost of a hunting licence should not be the barrier that keeps you from enjoying hunting.” - Trevor Horne, MLA for Spruce Grove-St. Albert “Hunting is a longstanding tradition and way of life for many people in our communities. The combination of the price reduction and mentorship opportunities available through the Alberta Hunter Education Instructors’ Association will help keep more hunters active in their senior years so they can provide a positive example for a new generation of hunters.” - Erin Babcock, MLA for Stony Plain

The UCP recently held their first organizational meeting in Onoway for the newly formed Lac Ste Anne Parkland Constituency. There was a board

elected and also a group of directors nominated by membership holders that were present. There are currently 5 candidates all vying for your vote to become the MLA for Lac Ste Anne Parkland. They are of varied backgrounds and live in different areas. Two of which are not in the riding. Regardless of who these people are and what they represent, they will not get my vote. I always like to discern even if it is just for myself what motivates people to do what they do and how they go about it. One candidate was caught in the boundary changes that happened recently. One outright knew and knows that this constituency is not where they live and has nothing to do with boundaries. I think what goes on in politics is sort of like the "old group" club.

I am all for change as I believe we cannot sustain what is currently transpiring in Alberta and in Canada. The parties that joined have understood that most people didn't vote for NDP but rather they voted change. I believe the change is right around the corner in the next election.

NEW APPROACH TO PHOENIX PAY SYSTEM ISSUES

Jim Eglinski, Member of Parliament for Yellowhead, is informing residents that Public Services and Procurement Canada has announced the introduction of a new approach to addressing Phoenix Pay System issues.

"Fixing the Phoenix pay system is long overdue. While we await the Liberal plan to re-

place Phoenix, 150,000 public servants, including many in our riding, still have outstanding pay requests that need to be processed," stated MP Eglinski.

Pay Pods are being introduced at the Miramichi Pay Centre to better support employees by processing pay transactions. Pay Pods, a concept developed by Pay Centre employees, group together compensation advisors assigned to a specific department or agency. These groups

will work with client departments to address all outstanding transactions in an employee's pay file, in contrast to the current approach of addressing pay issues by transaction type. This new approach is expected to result in more efficient and comprehensive resolutions of pay issues, and a reduction in backlogged cases.

Pay Pods will be rolled out to all departments and agencies serviced by the Pay Centre in

phases starting this month.

"The Auditor General estimated that because of Liberal inaction the Phoenix system would take more than half a billion dollars to fix. I urge the Minister of Public Services to make this a top priority," concluded MP Eglinski.


