RCMP Focus On Occupant Restraint Safety This Remembrance Day Weekend

"We remind Albertans to always wear a seatbelt and ensure all passengers are properly restrained," said Alberta Sheriff's Superintendent Rick Gardner. "Wearing occupant restraints is a simple and effective way to ensure your safety and that of others in a collision. It reduces the likelihood of sustaining an injury and decreases the severity of injury."

Alberta RCMP Traffic Services Superintendent Gary Graham noted, "In 2017, one in four collisions in Alberta RCMP jurisdictions involved a person not wearing a seatbelt." Graham went on to say, "Buckle up every single time you get in a vehicle. By taking responsibility for your own safe driving behaviour, you can help to make sure everyone gets home safely."

Thanks to our partnership with Provincial Sheriffs, our Integrated Traffic Units will continue to ensure that Albertans make safe driving decisions.

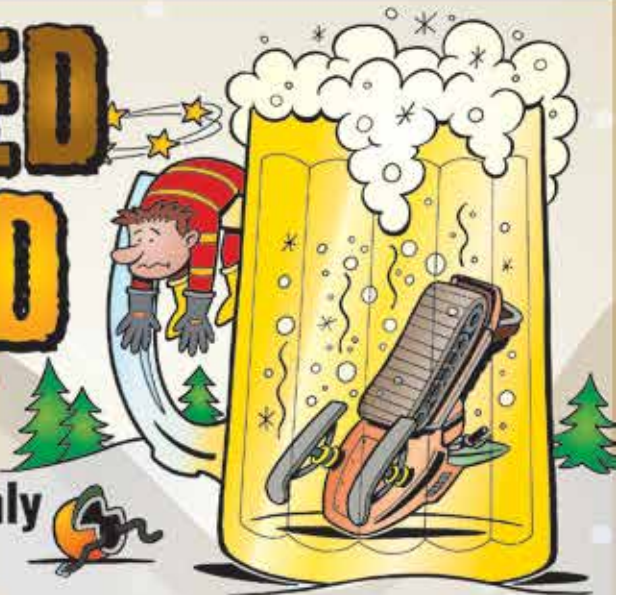

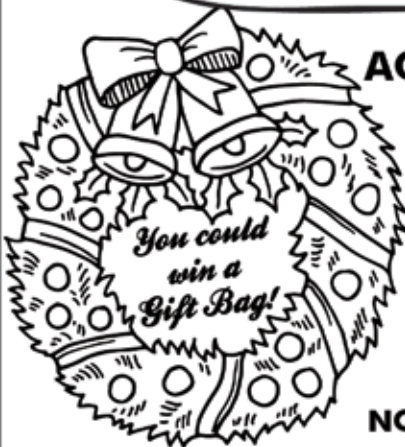

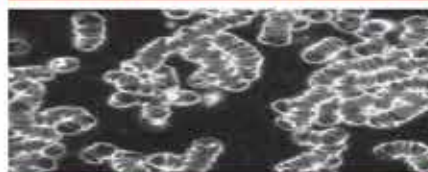
