





Landfill Bylaw Public Hearing – A number of county residents presented their opinions regarding a proposed land use bylaw amendment (Landfill and Composting District), which deals with the siting distance of Class 2 landfills in relation to existing residences. Council has attempted to provide a 1.5 km distance between future landfills and residences. This is over a kilometer farther than the industry standard of 450 metres.

Disaster Preparedness Equip-

ment - Following the recent wildland fire near the hamlet of Marlboro, administration has advised council to acquire several pieces of equipment which would be valuable to emergency disaster relief. The equipment list includes a cache of 55 deployable cots, bedding for said cots, hygiene kits, permanent beds for the Evansburg fire station (for staging crews) and various types of firefighting hose. County council approved funding in the amount of \$55,193 from reserves for the purchase of these items.

tion – Council moved to send Alberta Transportation a letter of support for the proposed speed limit reduction on Hwy 47:06, in the area of the Coal Valley Mine's development.

Property Tax Agreement – Council moved to enter into a property tax agreement with Canlin Energy Corporation which seeks to pay 50% of their 2019 tax amount owing (\$1,788,954.62) by June 30, 2019. The remaining amount will be paid in 6 equal monthly instalments ending December 31, 2019.

Council moved to enter into a property tax agreement with Yellowhead Notine Holdings Inc. which seeks to pay 50% of their 2019 tax amount owing (\$543,602.09) by June 30, 2019. The remaining amount will be paid in 6 equal monthly instalments ending December 31, 2019.

The next Council Meetings are June 25, 2019. The next Governance & Priorities Committee Meeting is July 16, 2019. All meetings start at 9:30 a.m. in the Council Chambers.

* changing the way we invest in tourism by developing Tourism Investment Groups where all levels of government will collaborate to invest more efficiently while meeting local priorities and identifying ways to raise private investment; and

* creating the new Tourism Industry Economic Strategy Table to provide a platform for government and industry leaders to collaborate on overcoming sector challenges.

"This strategy will stimulate growth in the tourism sector through new and ongoing investments," concluded MP Eglinski.
