RCMP FOCUS AUGUST ENFORCEMENT EFFORTS ON DISTRACTED DRIVING

Summers are a great time for Albertans to hit the roads and enjoy outdoor activities. With Heritage Day coming up, police expect an increased volume of drivers on Alberta roads.

During the 2018 Heritage Day long weekend, there were eight fatalities and 39 injuries as a result of motor vehicle collisions in Alberta RCMP jurisdictions.

"We remind Albertans that dis-

tracted driving can severely limit a driver's ability to focus on driving and road conditions," says Supt. Rick Gardner, Alberta Traffic Sheriffs. "Make sure to always put electronics away and to be prepared for unexpected actions of other road users and changing driving conditions such as construction."

"From January to June 2019, 5,063 distracted driving-related tickets were issued in Alberta RCMP jurisdictions. These high-risk driving behaviours are unacceptable," says Supt. Gary Graham, Alberta RCMP

Traffic Services. "Distracted driving can be as dangerous as impaired driving. Travelling safely from one location to another on our roadways is a shared responsibility: Whether someone is an experienced driver or a new one, we all need to work together to keep our roads safe."

We encourage road users to practice the following traffic safety tips:

- During construction season, follow all road signage to be prepared for speed changes and lane closures.
- Motorcyclists and cyclists should always ensure they are wearing the

proper protective gear.

• For drivers new to Alberta, always ensure that you know and are following the rules of the road as they can differ from country to country and even province to province.

TAKING ACTION TO MANAGE ENERGY (TAME+) PROJECTS

Submitted by Town of Whitecourt

The Town of Whitecourt received grant funding from the Municipal Climate Change Action Centre (MCCAC), through the Taking Ac-

tion to Manage Energy (TAME+) program, for several energy efficiency projects at Town recreational facilities.

An energy audit was completed in 2016 at the Allan & Jean Millar Centre and Scott Safety Centre,

which identified potential projects to improve energy efficiency and reduce greenhouse gas emissions. With the assistance of the TAME+ funding, completed projects included the following upgrades to the Allan & Jean Millar Centre: replace-

ment of metal halide and fluorescent bulbs with LED lighting (exterior, pool, fieldhouse and office lighting retrofits); and upgrades to the air handling units and swimming pool pumps through the inclusion of variable frequency drives. Projects at the Scott Safety Centre included the replacement of the make-up air unit and rooftop unit; replacement of interior and exterior metal halide and fluorescent bulbs with LED lighting, and the installation of new insulation and reflective ceiling at the Athabasca Rink. The electrical energy savings, due to the projects, is estimated at approximately 471,947 kWh/year.

The Municipal Climate Change Action Centre (MCCAC) provides funding, technical assistance, and education to support Alberta municipalities in addressing climate change by reducing their greenhouse gas emissions. The MCCAC is a partnership between the Government of Alberta, the Alberta Urban Municipalities Association (AUMA), and Rural Municipalities of Alberta (RMA).

REVITALIZING MUNICIPALITIES ACROSS ALBERTA

Submitted by Government of Alberta

The Municipal Government (Property Tax Incentives) Amendment Act would revitalize municipalities by empowering them to offer stronger property tax incentives to business and industry.

If passed, Bill 7 would allow municipalities to provide property tax incentives for up to 15 years, down from the year-to-year incentives they were allowed to provide previously.

"This legislation would empower municipalities to attract investment, create jobs and realize their full economic potential. Municipalities deserve the freedom and opportuni-

ty to make the choices that fit them best. I look forward to seeing this legislation bolster investment and economic development across our great province." - Kaycee Madu, Minister of Municipal Affairs

Under the proposed legislation, municipalities could decide how and if they want to implement property tax incentives – as local leaders are best suited to assess the economic needs of their communities.

"We are pleased the province is giving municipalities the ability to be creative in attracting new investments, and that they recognize there is a role for municipalities to play in creating a favourable environment for business and industry. Such incentives are tools that can

lay the foundation to create jobs and contribute to the long-term growth and prosperity of communities across Alberta." - Rod Frank, mayor, Strathcona County

The proposed bill supports government efforts to reduce red tape and uses an outcome-based approach to ensure regulatory processes are necessary, effective, efficient and proportional to the outcomes they are trying to achieve.

"As a developer of commercial, industrial and residential land, I know how important it is for municipalities to offer a business-friendly environment. This new legislation provides some much-needed flexibility for municipalities to be able to work with business to encourage

growth that will benefit the entire community." - Patrick Shaver, president, Avillia Developments

- This would give Alberta a competitive advantage over jurisdictions across Canada and the United States.

• Saskatchewan allows property tax incentives for up to five years; B.C. allows them for up to 10.

• Texas enables local tax incentives for up to 10 years.

• Louisiana offers five-year incentives with an option to renew for an additional five years.

CHARGES LAID IN EIA SECURITY BREACH

A 41-year-old male is presently in police custody and charges are pending.

INDIVIDUALS CONVICTED OF SIMPLE POSSESSION OF CANNABIS CAN NOW APPLY FOR NO-FEE, EXPEDITED PARDONS

MONTREAL, Aug. 1, 2019 / CNW/ - Starting today, people who have a criminal record only for simple possession of cannabis can apply for a pardon, which will make it easier to work, go to school, travel and actively participate in their communities.

The Minister of Justice and Attorney General of Canada, the Honourable David Lametti, on behalf of the Minister of Public Safety and Emergency Preparedness, the Honourable Ralph Goodale, today announced the coming into force of An Act to provide no-cost, expedited record suspensions for simple possession of cannabis.

“Starting today, individuals who were disproportionately impacted by cannabis laws of the past, including visible minorities, Indigenous people, and those in our most vulnerable neighbourhoods can finally shed the burden and stigma of that criminal record and have the ability to move forward positively in their lives.” - The Honourable Ralph Goodale, Minister of Public Safety and Emergency Preparedness

Individuals convicted only of simple possession of cannabis can now apply to the Parole Board of Canada (PBC) for a pardon through a streamlined, simplified process. The \$631 fee and waiting periods associated with other pardon applications are eliminated. Applicants will

be eligible even if they have outstanding fines or surcharges associated with their conviction, as long as they have completed the rest of their sentence.

“Providing free, immediate access to pardons will allow those with criminal records for simple possession of cannabis to move forward with their lives, making it easier to get a job, an education, rent an apartment or volunteer in their community.

This is particularly significant for marginalized communities in Canada, who have been disproportionately impacted by the enforcement of previous cannabis laws.” - The Honourable David Lametti, Minister of Justice and Attorney General of Canada

To assist applicants, PBC has put in place a streamlined Cannabis Record Suspension Application Guide and forms with step-by-step instructions, as well

as a toll-free information line and email address to answer questions. PBC is working with partners, including police, courts, community organizations and criminal justice professionals to maximize the positive impact of this new relief. GOLF COURSES MANAGE PESTS TO PROTECT THEIR TURF

(NC) Golf courses are valuable green spaces in many communities, and the sport is enjoyed by Canadians of all ages.

Turf insects feed on the grass and can inflict severe damage. Weeds are also a threat, because they compete with grass for moisture and affect the playability of a course.

To control pests, golf courses practice integrated pest management, using the right tool at the right time to treat an infestation. This includes pesticides, which are regulated by Health Canada to ensure they are safe and effective in controlling the pests they are designed to target. They help maintain healthy vegetation and playing

surfaces, and also offer many environmental benefits.

Golf courses are often located in urbanized areas and can be valuable green spaces that help

preserve habitats for wildlife and waterfowl. Data show that healthy turf and trees act as natural air conditioners by producing large amounts of oxygen, while remov-

ing carbon dioxide. Did you know that healthy turf grass can sequester almost 900 kilograms of carbon per hectare each year?
