

Police determined the shot was not fired by the

FLOOD WATCH & SPRING RUNOFF ADVISORY - ROAD CLOSURES

Submitted by County of Barrhead

A flood watch has been issued by Alberta Environment & Parks for, both, the Paddle and Little Paddle Rivers, as a result of rapid snow melt and an accelerated rise in water levels.

Overland flooding has been reported in the County of Barrhead. As the air temperatures are forecast to increase over the next few days, water levels are expected to rise.

Paddle River continues to rise downstream of the Paddle Reservoir in response to increased flows from the Little Paddle and other local streams and rivers. Over-topping of the Paddle River Dyke has

been observed and flooding of agricultural land is expected.

The County is working diligently to manage rising water from spring runoff by actively monitoring levels, steaming culverts, mitigating damage to infrastructure and preventing hazardous conditions.

Current Road Closures

- Low Level Bridge crossing the Paddle River on Rge. Rd.40, also known as the Golf Course Road, north of Twp. Rd. 592.

- Twp. Rd. 584 between Rge. Rd. 60 and Rge. Rd. 61A

- Twp. Rd. 591 between Rge. Rd. 51 and Rge. Rd. 52

We ask residents to exercise caution around the river as bank stability is reduced during high water events. Please respect signage and barricades. Debris and undercurrents pose significant dangers. Please do not allow children to play near flooded waterways.

3 PERENNIAL GARDENING POINTERS

WHITECOURT TOWN COUNCIL UPDATE

Submitted by Town of Whitecourt

MAY 13, 2020

Whitecourt Town Council adopted Tax Rate Bylaw 1559 at the May 11, 2020 Electronic Regular Meeting, and property owners can expect to receive combined assessment and taxation notices later this month. The 2020 Budget included a decrease to the municipal tax rate, including seniors and education requisitions, and for the average property owner this means:

- 4.52% total tax rate reduction for residential properties;
- 4.49% total tax rate reduction for non-residential properties.

The property tax deadline for 2020 has been extended to August 31, 2020 as part of COVID-19 relief measures for property

owners. For details on how property taxes are calculated, and how tax dollars have been allocated in the 2020 Budget, please read the 2020 Budget Report. The report is available online at www.whitecourt.ca/Government. If you have questions about your tax notice or the 2020 Budget, please contact the Town Office.

Town Council received an overview of 2020 assessment figures by the municipal assessor at the May 11 Electronic Regular Meeting.

- The valuation date for 2020 taxation of properties is July 1, 2019.

- Assessment values for single family homes have decreased approximately 4.1% in the valley area, and 2.4% in the hilltop area. The average house value in Whitecourt is \$329,200.

- Property owners can view the assessment report for their property online. Visit the Whitecourt website at www.whitecourt.ca/Services/Taxes-Assessment and follow the link and instructions to view assessment reports.

- Property owners will receive a combined assessment and tax notice later this month.

The Town of Whitecourt has experienced revenue losses and unexpected expenditures related to COVID-19. The length of the economic disruption and recovery is not known; however, the Town of Whitecourt intends to address these impacts through funding strategies that will not affect taxation. Whitecourt Town Council has reallocated \$1.5 million from existing reserves to establish a Sustainability Reserve that will ensure the continuation of essential services and also minimize impact on taxation for future years as our community returns to normal. Ongoing monitoring and reporting of the financial impacts will provide for fiscal responsibility during this unprecedented event.

The Community Services Department has published its 2019 Year End Report. The report is prepared annually to provide Council and the Community Services Advisory Board with an overview of programs and services offered, and records major projects and accomplishments achieved throughout the year. Highlights from the report include:

- The Allan & Jean Millar Centre launched the Intelligenz Customer Registration Web Portal allowing customers to register online.

- Daily admission revenue in 2019 was the highest it has ever been since the Allan & Jean Millar Centre opened in 2008.

- 2,023 people participated in registered programs;

- 47,404 visits to the Pembina Fitness Centre and Rotary Running Track;

- 5,226 people attended the Rotary Club of Whitecourt free family swims at the SemCAMS Midstream Aquatic Centre;

- 1,846 people were assisted through the Whitecourt Food Bank;

- 4,036 participants attended Parent Link & Early Childhood Development programs;

- 30,610 passengers were provided service on Public Transit, representing a 25% increase in ridership between 2017 and 2019.

STAGE 1 OF ALBERTA'S RELAUNCH STRATEGY STARTED MAY 14

Submitted by Town of Whitecourt

MAY 12, 2020

The Town of Whitecourt is preparing for the reopening of local businesses as part of Alberta's phased in Relaunch Strategy. As of May 14, businesses included in stage 1 of the strategy will be able to open with enhanced infection prevention and controls in place. Included in stage 1 are clothing and furniture stores, farmer's markets, cafés, restaurants, and some personal services including hair salons and barber shops.

"This is great news for our local business owners and entrepreneurs, as well as our community," stated Whitecourt Mayor Maryann Chichak. "For the last several weeks, Whitecourt staff have been working with our partners and the business community to navigate the public health orders and relief funding programs and initiatives. It's exciting that we can move on to a step that involves supporting them on their reopening."

"While this is an exciting step in the relaunch phases, there are health and safety protocols that will be required of local businesses for their reopening," added Whitecourt Economic Development Officer, Rhonda Hough. "In partnership with the Whitecourt & District Chamber of Commerce, Community Futures Yellowhead East and other support organizations, we have and will continue to communicate and promote these guidelines to the local business community."

The timing of phases where the Town of Whitecourt could consider reopening facilities will be determined based on the success of stage 1 and preceding stages. Whitecourt

will continue to monitor the COVID-19 situation, and is preparing a plan to reopen facilities and relaunch programming based on the recommendations by the Government of Alberta. Further information on the opening of outdoor recreational facilities, such as the Whitecourt River Slides and Rotary Park Splash Park, will be announced later this week once guidance has been received from the Province.

"The timing of other reopen-

ings will hinge on how stage 1 goes," added Mayor Maryann Chichak. "As a community, we have been extremely vigilant in following public health measures, and we will have to continue to follow these guidelines through this gradual opening of services to help prevent the spread of COVID-19. Mass gathering restrictions continue to be in place, and physical distancing practices continue to be recommended by the Alberta Chief Medical Officer."
