JOBS AND GROWTH FUND

Gerald Soroka, Member of Parliament for Yellowhead, wishes to advise that the Minister of Economic Development and Official Languages, has announced that businesses and organizations across Canada can now submit applications through the new Jobs and

Growth Fund. Applications are being accepted on a continuous intake basis until March 31, 2024, or until funding is fully committed.

Delivered by Canada's Regional Development Agencies (RDAs), the new fund provides \$700 million nationally over three years to support a regional response and stimulate economic recovery following the

COVID-19 crisis by investing in projects that will help to create jobs over the next three years and beyond. This includes up to \$70 million dedicated to businesses created after January 2020 that meet eligibility criteria.

FULL REFUNDS FOR SUNWING FLIGHTS CANCELLED

Gerald Soroka, Member of Parliament for Yellowhead, wishes to advise that Sunwing will be offering full customer refunds after reaching a deal with the Canada Enterprise Emergency Funding Corp. allowing more customers to receive refunds.

Those with non-refundable

bookings whose vacations were cancelled due to the pandemic, and who have received a future travel credit or travel vouchers, can now request a full refund or keep their travel credit.

Future travel credits are available for travel up to Sept. 30, 2026.

To request a refund, eligible customers and travel agents

must submit a request through an online COVID-19 refund request form by Aug. 27.

The new policy applies to hotels, flights and vacation packages booked on or before Friday, June 25, 2021 for travel scheduled on or after Feb. 1, 2020.

NEW CANADA DISABILITY BENEFIT LEGISLATION

Gerald Soroka, Member of Parliament for Yellowhead, wishes to advise that Employment, Workforce Development and Disability Inclusion, has introduced new legislation that would establish the framework for a new Canada Disability Benefit to support working-age Canadians with disabilities. The Canada Dis-

ability Benefit would supplement, not replace, existing federal and provincial-territorial supports with a goal of lifting hundreds of thousands of persons with disabilities out of poverty.

The Government of Canada will build on the legislation introduced today to engage with stakeholders and persons with disabilities to have their voices heard on the design of the benefit leading up

to the development of regulations. Public engagement on the Disability Inclusion Action Plan is open until August 31, 2021.

The Disability Inclusion Action Plan (DIAP) will include:

- a new Canada Disability Benefit;
- a robust employment strategy for Canadians with disabilities and,
- a better process to determine eligibility for federal dis-

ability programs and benefits.

TOURISM RELIEF FUND

Gerald Soroka, Member of Parliament for Yellowhead, wishes to advise that \$500 million in funding over two years (2021-2022 and 2022-2023) has been launched for the new Tourism Relief Fund. Eligible organizations can now submit applications to support the tourism sector prepare to welcome back domestic travelers and reposition Canada as a world-class destination.

Canada's Regional Development Agencies (RDAs) will deliver \$485 million directly to businesses and organizations to help them adapt their operations to meet public health requirements while investing in products and services to facilitate future growth. Under the Fund, \$50 million will specifically support Indigenous tourism initiatives.

In addition, \$15 million, delivered by Innovation, Science and Economic Development Canada, will support destination development, seasonal and local attractions, and human resources and skills development.

GYPSED Transportation Services FAQ and Information Guide

What Transportation Services are Offered through GYPSED?

GYPSED strives to offer a range of services that are fair and equitable. Board Policy 17 is aligned with the province's *Education Act* and the *Student Transportation Regulation*. Services are available for:

- **Eligible:** Students who live more than 2.4 km away from their designated school
- **Ineligible:** Students who live less than 2.4 km away from their designated school
- **School of Choice:** Students who chose to attend a school other than their designated school
- **Transportation Out of District:** Students who chose to attend a different school jurisdiction
- **Alternate Second Seat:** Students who require a reserved second seat on a different bus to an alternate address

What Transportation Services are School Jurisdictions Funded to Provide?

Alberta Education Transportation Funding is for:

- Students residing more than 2.4 km away from their designated school
- Students with special needs who require specialized transportation

Under the School Transportation Regulation, school divisions are not required to transport students beyond their designated school.

How Do I Determine my Child's Designated School?

Please visit the Division's website at www.gypsd.ca under **For Parents/Student Transportation** and enter your home address on the link *What is My Designated School?*

Why does Transportation Services Charge Fees for Some Services?

Fees are established to support transportation services for the jurisdiction's families who request them and to ensure classroom dollars are not being used to address transportation service funding gaps.

User fees are charged to parents of students who access transportation services as a way to recover the unfunded costs. GYPSED service fees are amongst the lowest in the province.

How is Eligibility for Transportation Determined?

- Alberta Education provides funding to eligible riders only.
- The distance of 2.4 kms for busing to the student's designated school is set by Alberta Education.
- The government sets eligibility based on the student's primary residence address and distance from home to designated school.

Do I Need to Register for the Bus?

NEW for the 2021/2022 School Year: All **new** and **returning** students requiring transportation services must register. Registration is now open.

How Do I Register for the Bus?

Registration for transportation services is at www.gypsd.ca under **For Parents/Student Transportation**. Only eligible riders are guaranteed a seat each year. All other riders are subject to seat availability.

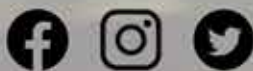

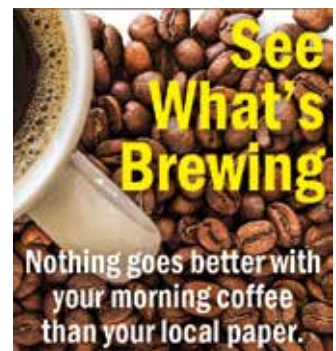
munity.
