becoming a volunteer has been very impressed with the SANG-sponsored volunteer recognition program. Since September, we have had 58 volunteers create 273 volunteer visits.

Of the 58 volunteers, 26 people are first-time volunteers this year. The majority of them are “one time” volunteers so far. We hope these individuals will return for a second and third time

in 2023. For example, the Cadet parents have already indicated that they would like to organize a second Friday night dinner.

A “volunteer visit” means a volunteer has come into the legion to donate their time either at the bar, as a kitchen helper or as a chef. All other various volunteer visits have been placed in one of the three categories most related to its function. They do not include individuals attending

board or committee meetings nor shopping for the bar or the kitchen.

Our top five volunteers comprise 40% of the volunteer visits. Increasing the number of volunteers, and especially for repeat visits, is key to addressing the “volunteer burnout” which has been a problem recently.






