## WHITECOURT CREWS TO START GREEN SPACE MAINTENANCE PROJECTS NEXT WEEK

Whitecourt crews will be undertaking tree maintenance and FireSmart vegetation management projects in green spaces throughout the hilltop area starting June 10, 2024.

Projects involve falling and

removing dying or damaged trees to reduce the risk to local infrastructure (fences, sheds, etc.), as well as completing FireSmart vegetation management practices to reduce the potential impact of forest fires in the community.

Work areas include:

- between the Whitecourt

Healthcare Centre and Highway 43 Pathway;

- between Caxton Street and Pineview Road/Park Drive North;

- west of Southland Park; and,
- south of Park Court and Park Lane.

Crews will be working between 7am and 5pm Monday

through Friday, and will be using chainsaws and equipment to complete the work. The public is asked to obey all posted signs and barricades while staff perform this work.

# FUNDING TO SUPPORT ALBERTANS AS THEY AGE

Submitted by Government of Alberta

A new Aging with Dignity funding agreement with the federal government will enhance Alberta's continuing care transformation efforts to support Albertans as they age.

Albertans deserve a continuing care system that ensures they can access the highest quality of care available when and where they need it. To meet the growing needs of an aging population and ensure

the future of the province's continuing care system, Alberta's government has committed \$1 billion over three years to transform continuing care in Alberta. This work includes supporting initiatives that will shift to deliver more care in the community, enhance workforce capacity, increase choice and innovation, and improve quality of care within the continuing care sector.

To support Alberta's continuing care transformation work and help Albertans age

with dignity, Alberta's government has signed a five-year, \$627 million bilateral funding agreement with the federal government to support home care and continuing care home initiatives.

"We are committed to making sure Albertans have the care they need as they age. This funding will complement the significant continuing care transformation investments Alberta's government is making and the improvements we are putting in place to meet the

growing care needs of Albertans as they age. This transformational work will provide Albertans high-quality care close to home and will build a responsive and sustainable continuing care system for years to come."

Home care initiatives will include enhancing home care services, improving access to palliative and end-of-life care, increasing support for caregivers, and expanding non-medical supports. Continuing care home initiatives will include supporting quality of life best practices in home care and continuing care homes, expanding continuing care workforce education, training and development opportunities, providing workforce mental health supports, and enhancing compliance and monitoring capacity for continuing care homes.

In addition to this funding, the province has allocated \$654 million over three years for the Continuing Care Capital Program to improve access to continuing care spaces for Albertans, including those who no longer need to stay at a hospital but require further support. The capital funding will also support efforts to reduce emergency department wait times by freeing up more beds and making sure Albertans are getting the right supports in the appropriate setting.

"Providing our residents with quality of life, access to innovative and sustainable services, and giving them a sense of belonging to a community are fundamental principles of The Good Samaritan Society. This funding agreement will support us and other care providers in meeting our goals in the years to come."

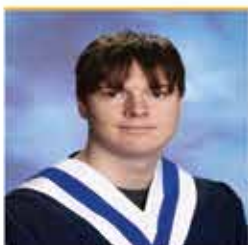

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 692 of the *Municipal Government Act*, the Council of Lac Ste. Anne County is considering an application for amendment to Land Use Bylaw 22-2017, by amending the section that defines development that does not require a development permit.

- The proposed amendment to Land Use Bylaw regulations defining development that does not require development permits include: 3.2.1(a)(d)(e)(k)(l) and (q) are all proposed to be amended.
- New addition includes: 3.2.1(w) which would not require development permit approval for solar energy installations on structures. The size of solar energy installation would not exceed size of roof it is placed upon, and the structure must have all necessary development and building permits. This point will highlight that the development authority does not waive building or electrical permit requirements, only development permit requirements subject to the above requirements.
- 15.1.175 "Solar Energy Installation" means the development of a renewable or alternative energy generating unit that collects sunlight to convert into thermal or electrical energy.

# AXE THE TAXES FOR SUMMER

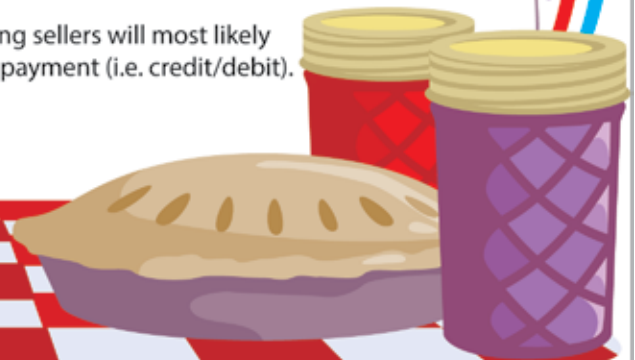

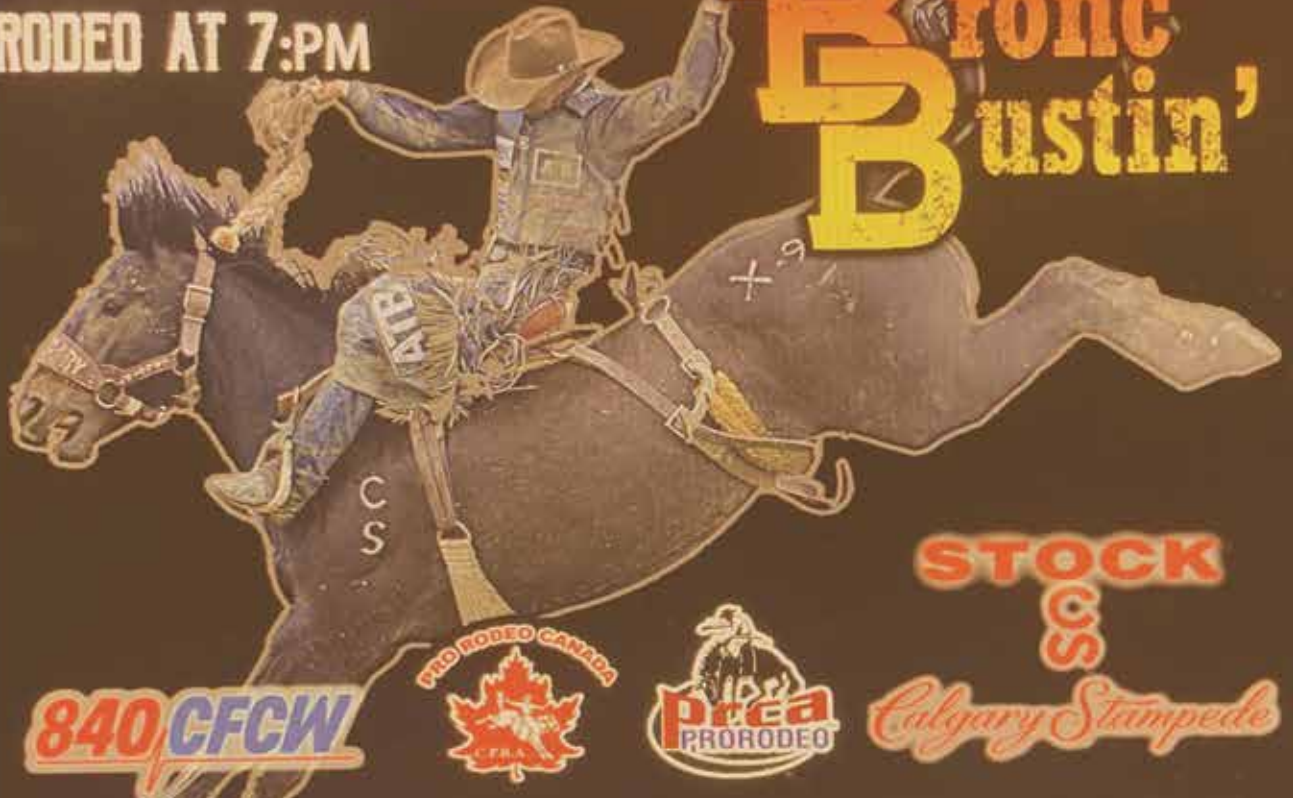
