TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF ONOWAY FIRE STATION

Submitted by Fire Rescue International (Division 7801)

Fire Rescue International (FRI) was notified by the Town of Onoway yesterday morning that within hours vehicle access to the Onoway Fire Station will be restricted for approximately 8 days due to concrete curb repairs. Unfortunately, no

contingency plan was devised to maintain the same level of service, capacity, or turnout speed (chute time), and alternative proposals to keep at least part of the station operational have been denied.

Despite these challenges, FRI remains committed to providing the best possible service to the residents and communities served by

the Onoway Fire Station. Through last-minute negotiations with the Town of Onoway, FRI has arranged for one pumper to be kept on standby at the town's public works building and a fast-response unit to be stationed at the Onoway barracks. Additionally, in accordance with FRI policy, a second unit will be

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

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PARKLAND RCMP SEEK OWNERS OF STOLEN FIREARMS

On June 12, 2024, at approximately 12:20 a.m., Parkland RCMP received a report of a suspicious white GMC Sierra truck with an attached flat deck trailer parked on a dead-end road in the residential area near Duffield, Alta.. Police located the suspicious vehi-

cle and conducted a traffic stop. The lone male driver was a suspended driver and he was wanted on outstanding warrants. When the driver opened the driver's door of the GMC truck, police observed a fake Vehicle Identification Number (VIN) attached to the door. The initial police investigation determined that the GMC truck and trailer were

stolen, and a further search uncovered suspected Methamphetamine, one prohibited firearm, seven other firearms and two prohibited devices (over capacity magazines), also believed to be stolen. The suspect is known to police and he was arrested without incident.

Kalen Mailhot, 41-year-old resident of Parkland County was charged with:

- Possession of a firearm
- Possession of a prohibited weapon
- Possession of a weapon
- Fraud
- Altering or removing a VIN (x2)
- Possession of methamphetamine

Mailhot was taken before a Justice of the Peace and remanded into custody and his next appearance is June 19, 2024, at the Alberta Court of Justice in Stony Plain, Alta..

The Parkland RCMP are trying to reunite the recovered stolen firearms with the rightful owners, therefore, if you had a firearm stolen and have not reported the police, please contact the Parkland RCMP at 825-220-7267 to file a report. Anyone trying to claim the firearms will be required to provide the make, model and serial number.

The Parkland RCMP would also like to thank the public for being vigilant and reporting this suspicious vehicle to the police, which had a successful outcome in recovering stolen property and removing unlawful firearms from the street.

NORTHERN AND REGIONAL ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM FUNDS MAIN STREET REHABILITATION PROJECT

Mayerthorpe, Alberta, June 17, 2024 –

Mayerthorpe has received official notification of its application being approved under the Northern and Regional Economic Development (NRED) Program!

Main Street Rehabilitation Project provides for repairs to curb and gutter, brick sidewalk, drainage channels, and drainage channel heat trace. Additional enhancements include new digital sign, benches, garbage receptacles, and flower containers. Rehabilitation will result in increased safety, improved storm water drainage, and beautification of Main Street.


Staff are currently seeking quotes to complete the work which is anticipated to be completed by October 2024.

The Project is made possible with 50% funding from the Northern and Regional Economic Development Program with the remainder from the Town totalling \$200,000!

"Things are hopping on our main street! Businesses are selling, buildings are getting facelifts and new businesses are opening. It's fitting that we're working on upgrading sidewalks and curb & gutter, not to mention the beautification items that will enhance the appearance of our main street", said Jabush. WEED INSPECTION UPDATE You Will Encounter Weed Inspectors in the Area

If you see County weed inspectors in your area, they are visiting every property to check for noxious weeds identified by the provincial *Weed Control Act*. If they find noxious weeds, a weed inspection report will be mailed to the landowner.

Under the provincial *Weed Control Act*, County weed inspectors have the appointed authority to enter any private property to monitor for noxious and prohibited noxious weeds and enforce compliance with the Act.

The purpose of this program is to educate and inform property owners about regulated weeds found on their land. In-person visits are conducted to provide the most effective guidance and support.

Here's how it works:

1.Initial Contact: The inspector will attempt to contact you in person at your residence. This allows us to start the conversation and book an inspection.

2.No Response: If you are not home, they will leave a door knocker card with a date range for their return visit and contact information for any questions you may have and to book an inspection appointment.

3.Inspection: On their return, the inspector will enter the property to check for noxious and prohibited noxious weeds. Inspectors will not go past closed gates or enter areas with livestock without permission.

Please note, under the *Weed Control Act*, it is illegal to willfully obstruct or delay an inspector in their duties.

The County has been setting beaver traps in problematic locations including ditches and ravines. Residents are strongly encouraged to keep their pets on leashes if they plan to venture into ditches. If you encounter a beaver trap, do not go near or touch it; a beaver trap is a dangerous device.

If you are trapping beavers, please make sure to follow the Code of Responsible Trapping, available at [albertaregulations.ca](https://www.albertaregulations.ca).

Finally, as stated in the *2024-25 Alberta Guide to Trapping Regulations* – "Fur-bearing animals must be trapped using methods that are proven to avoid unnecessary pain and suffering. The manner in which animals are trapped is a concern of many Albertans, including trappers."
