

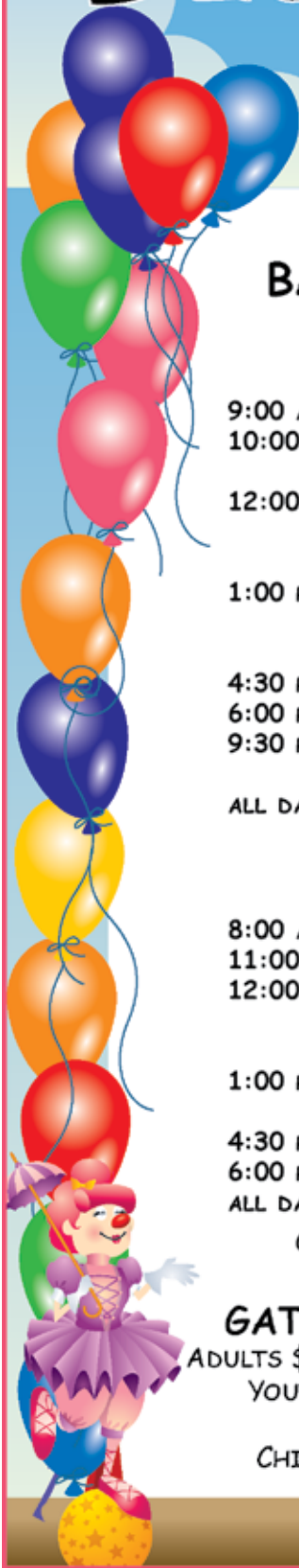

# RCMP FEDERAL POLICING, NORTHWEST REGION CHARGES TWO INDIVIDUALS FOR UTTERING THREATS AGAINST PUBLIC FIGURES

The RCMP Federal Policing Integrated National Security Enforcement Team (INSET), Northwest Region has arrested and charged two individuals for uttering threats against several public figures in two separate investigations. –

On May 10, 2024, INSET received information that a user of the social media platform “X”, formerly known as Twitter, had allegedly posted threats to kill Prime Minister Justin Trudeau. On June 6, 2024, Mason John Baker, 23, a resident of Calgary, was charged with uttering threats against a person contrary to section 264.1(1)(a) of the Criminal Code.

On June 7, 2024, INSET

received information that a YouTube account user had allegedly posted threats to kill Prime Minister Justin Trudeau, Deputy Prime Minister Chrystia Freeland and New Democrat Leader Jagmeet Singh. On June 13, 2024, Garry Belzevick, 67, a resident of Edmonton, was charged with three counts of uttering threats against a person contrary to section 264.1(1)(a) of the Criminal Code.

Baker is scheduled to appear at the Alberta Court of Justice in Calgary on July 23, 2024. Belzevick is scheduled to appear at the Alberta Court of Justice in Edmonton on July 25, 2024.

The RCMP is mandated to investigate criminal offences arising from terrorism, espionage, cyber attacks, nuclear security risks, for-

eign influenced activities, incidents involving the security of an Internationally Protected Person (IPPs), the unlawful release of national security information and terrorist financing.

As part of its protective mandate, the RCMP is responsible for safeguarding designated Canadians and select foreign diplomatic personnel residing in Canada, as per Article 22 of the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations, as well as visiting IPPs.

The security environment in which public figures operate continues to evolve both within Canada and abroad, and we recognize this is a time for increased vigilance.

“In the digital age, where so many interactions occur online and are perceived

to be anonymous, there is a belief that virtual actions and words do not have consequences. When these virtual actions or words cross the boundaries of Charter-protected speech and constitute criminal activity, police will investigate thoroughly to hold those responsible accountable.”

## WORLD DAY AGAINST TRAFFICKING IN PERSONS: JOINT STATEMENT

Minister of Public Safety and Emergency Services Mike Ellis, Minister of Children and Family Services Searle Turton, Minister of Arts, Culture and Status of Women Tanya Fir issued the following statement on the World Day Against Trafficking in Persons:

“Human trafficking is a brutal crime that traps victims in a cycle of abuse and dehumanization. The trauma and psychological damage inflicted by human trafficking can be profound, leaving survivors with long-lasting

scars and a profound sense of fear and mistrust. We are committed to fighting all types of human trafficking wherever it exists in our province. We must work together across jurisdictions to disrupt and deter this horrific criminal activity. Alberta’s government will do whatever it takes to keep human trafficking from hurting our communities, and we will continue to strive to eliminate it in our province.”

## COUNTY CROP INSPECTIONS FOR CLUBROOT OF CANOLA Starting Soon!

Lac Ste. Anne County performs an annual inspection of all canola fields throughout the region, per **Policy 02-010-003 Control of Clubroot Disease**. This is done to monitor the pathogen's movement and reduce the spread throughout the County. In order to help producers make their own informed cropping decisions and reduce their risks, the County offers a map that shows where clubroot has been identified in canola. A copy of this map is available for viewing on our website.

Field staff will take all necessary bio-security precautions when entering a field for inspection including wearing disposable gloves and boot covers and sanitizing equipment between fields.

## BLUE-GREEN ALGAE ADVISORIES IN PLACE

### Lac La Nonne Added to the Growing List of Lakes

Alberta Health Services (AHS) has issued a BLUE-GREEN ALGAE ADVISORY for Isle Lake, the Paddle River Dam Reservoir, Lac Ste. Anne, and recently added Lac La Nonne. Signs are posted at the affected lakes. Further advisories are anticipated in the region.

To protect yourself and your pets, AHS advises to avoid contact with blue-green algae blooms, don't swim in water where blue-green algae is visible, and do not drink or cook with water from this lake.

If you suspect a problem related to blue-green algae or if you require further information on health concerns and blue-green algae, please call Health Link at 811. Additional information is also available online at [ahs.ca/eph](http://ahs.ca/eph).

Please note that areas of the lake in which the blue-green algae bloom is not visible can still be used for recreational purposes, even while this Blue-Green Algae Health Advisory is in place.



# ALBERTA RCMP RESPOND TO STRUCTURE COLLAPSE IN WESLOCK COUNTY

Despite attempts at medical intervention one individual has died as a result of their injuries.

On July 31, 2024, at 5:27 p.m., Westlock RCMP received a report of a structure collapse caused by severe weather at the Westlock Medication Center (Tu Vien Tay Thien) near Busby Alta. Westlock RCMP were joined by officers from several other nearby detachments, EMS, and fire crews in assisting multiple injured people who were near or inside a large tent structure when it collapsed. Several injured people were taken by EMS to area hospitals.

Occupational Health and Safety have been advised and have investigators on site. The RCMP is currently conducting an investigation into the circumstances of this incident.

The Alberta RCMP wish to express our heartfelt condolences to the family and friends of the deceased, and those injured during this incident.

If you put your combustible things too close to a big fire; chances are they will get burnt as well. Things live, things die, and the lifespans of some things are longer than others, even amongst types of living things, plants, trees, animals, wild and tame, big and small, these are just known common sense truths. Weather changes, heck we have 4 seasons here in our corner of the world, some may argue 2... winter and road construction season, but most would agree on 4, with 2 major ones. Summer and Winter. Some winters are warmer than others, and some summers are colder than others, as well most know, precipitation varies as well.

So why is it, that we over the last several years, have thrown common sense to the wind, and thought because we changed some words on a paper, and that if we changed policy, that mother nature and common sense would change because us hairless monkeys put pen to paper? Is it ignorance, arrogance, or both. We are nothing on the time scale of the planet, and we are at present the top of the

food chain, but nothing in the face of nature. All the king's horses, and all the king's men as it were...

There have been a good many of people over the last ten years ringing the warning bell when it comes to forest management. This is not just an Alberta thing, it's a western state, and western province thing for sure, but frankly, a forested country thing. Recently there was a session I attended down in Oregon on the policies and protocols that they and several of the western states have been using to deal with similar challenges. The ADM put it in a straightforward manner, "Choose your Smoke". Either you chose to allow for the forestry to have controlled burns in area, with select logging and underbrush removal, or mother nature will burn where and when she wants.

There had been a change over the years, to allow for less and less management of the forests, well that's all good, except for where people live, or have remote access, or limited routes. I can tell you full well, we have lots of trees, and like our friends in the USA, our forests are mature. They don't live to the ripe old age of Redwoods...heck, 100 years is ancient. Most make it in between the 80 to 100 year range, that's just the nature of the types of for-

ests we have. In Idaho, they have also enlisted, and authorized farmers, if they see a fire started on federal, or state lands, they are empowered to take action, and put it out before it gets going. Common sense is still alive!

We need to modernize the way we manage our forests, not just with fancy new gear, not with computers, not just with all of the technology, but in common sense. Sometimes what is old is new again. If there is an infestation of beetles as an example, and it kills the forests for miles around the towns, perhaps that material should be managed. This would include thinning, removal of the dead trees, in a reasonable distance, so that when mother nature decides to clean it up...our towns are protected.

The layers of authority and the policies between the authorities need to consider one thing. That there is only one tax payer, and there is only one fire. Neither the taxpayer will be saved by layers of red tape, inaction, or debate, nor will the fire be prevented by procrastination and ignoring the blatantly obvious.

My hope for this year's fire season, is that we will not repeat mistakes, that we will learn, that the politics get parked, the common sense items, the low hanging fruit will get immediately im-

plemented. We can no longer stick our heads in the sand, while the Green Gremlin takes the stage and tells us all about their vision, because honestly, mother nature isn't listening, and either we clean up this mess, or she will!
