MAYERTHORPE RCMP ON SCENE AT COLLISION ON HIGHWAY 43 CONCLUSION

On Mar. 13, 2025 at approximately 4:15P.M., Mayerthorpe RCMP responded to a report of a motor vehicle collision involving a school bus and a

pickup truck. Through the course of the investigation, it was learned that a local school bus was in the center meridian area of the highway, attempting to cross the highway with approximately 8 children on board.

Due to very poor weather conditions and blowing snow, as the bus progressed, a pickup truck emerged from the blowing snow, striking the rear of the bus and causing it to partially spin.

IS IT TIME FOR YOUR MAMMOGRAM?

Screen Test is coming to Mayerthorpe March 31 to April 3 & Onoway April 4 to 6, 2025

Screen Test is a free service provided by Alberta Health Services that offers screening mammograms. Our mobile screening units travel to 120 communities throughout Alberta to provide convenient access to breast cancer screening.

Having regular screening mammograms is the best way to find breast cancer early,

before symptoms appear and when treatment may work better.

Who should have a screening mammogram?

If you're 45 to 74, you don't need a referral to have a mammogram. Make screening part of your regular health routine. Plan to have a mammogram every 2 years or as decided by you and your healthcare provider.

If you're 40 to 44 or over 75, discuss the risks and benefits of screening with your healthcare provider. You will need a referral if you're 40 to 44 and it's your first mammogram, or

if you're over 75.

Call 1-800-667-0604 (toll-free) to book a mammogram with Screen Test.

Breast density scores are now included in your Screen Test result letter

Breast density is the amount of dense tissue compared to the amount of fat in a person's breasts. It can be harder to find cancer in dense breasts because this tissue appears white on a mammogram, the same colour as many kinds of breast cancer. It's common to have dense breast tissue.

Dense breasts are only one of many risk factors for breast

cancer. Other factors, such as age and genetics, have a bigger impact on your overall risk. You can't tell how dense your breasts are by size, look or feel. The only way to find out is by having a mammogram.

DID YOU KNOW? DRIVER'S AGE

The United States and Canada have two of the lowest minimum age driving requirements in the world. Minimum driving age requirements vary by the state and province in the United States and Canada, respectively. However, in many areas of the United States, drivers can begin driving with a learner's permit around the age of 14 (drivers with learner's permits often must be accompanied by fully licensed drivers), while the minimum driving age in most Canadian provinces is 16 (it is 14 in Alberta).

Rica, Honduras and Nicaragua also make young people wait until the age of 18 before they can get behind the wheel. Much of South America is the same, with only Argentina (17) and Chile (17 with parental approval) allowing young people to drive before they turn 18. Many countries in Asia, including China (18), India (18 for cars, 16 for gearless bikes under 50 cc) and Japan (18 for cars and motorcycles over 401 cc), also have higher minimum age driving requirements than the United States and Canada.

Probationary licences

The vast majority of child-care providers and educators in Alberta are committed to the safety and well-being of the children in their care.

If a licenced child-care program is unable to meet the standards set out by Alberta's government, they can be subject to enforcement action, including suspension of their licence and probation. Through continued monitoring, further

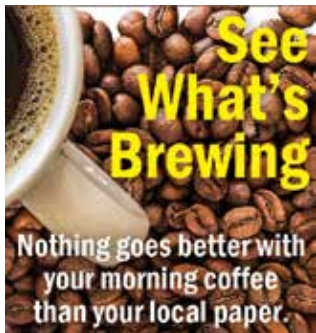
