### LEDUC RCMP ON SCENE AT SERIOUS MOTOR VEHICLE COLLISION CONCLUSION

On April 2, 2025, at 8:34 p.m., Leduc RCMP received a report of a 2-vehicle collision on Highway 21 at Township 502 in Leduc

County. Upon arrival, both occupants of one of the vehicles, a Kia Forte, were deceased. The driver and sole occupant of the other vehicle, a Hyundai Santa Fe, was taken to hospital with

serious injuries.

RCMP remained on scene for several hours investigating.

### DRAYTON VALLEY RCMP MAKE ARRESTS IN DRUG TRAFFICKING INVESTIGATION

On March 28, 2025, as a result of a month-long investigation, the Drayton Valley RCMP General Investigation Section (GIS) executed a drug search warrant at a local motel. As a result of the search, two

people, one man and one woman, were arrested and the following items were seized:

- Methamphetamine, cocaine and fentanyl, most pre-packaged;
- A rifle that had been stolen in Mayerthorpe, Alta., in 2008;
- Several weapons including

knives and a baton; and

•Over \$1500 in Canadian currency.

### THE CONSUMER CARBON TAX IS GONE: MINISTER NALLY

Minister of Service Alberta and Red Tape Reduction Dale Nally issued the following statement on the elimination of federal carbon taxes on fuel:

“The time has come. After years of relentless pressure from our government, the federal conservatives and other provincial governments across Canada, the federal government has finally scrapped its punishing consumer carbon tax

that has wreaked havoc on Canadians’ personal finances.

“With the removal of this costly tax, Alberta drivers will save an average of \$215 per year at the pumps. Our government expects

## Drayton Valley RCMP Make Arrests In Drug Trafficking Investigation

- oPossession of a controlled substance for the purpose of trafficking (X3);
- oCarrying a concealed weapon;
- oPossession of a weapon for a dangerous purpose (X3);
- oPossession of a prohibited weapon;
- oFirearm related offences (x18); and
- oPossession of Proceeds of Crime under \$5000.

•Courtney Haubi (26), a resident of Drayton Valley, was charged with:

- oPossession of a controlled substance for the purpose of trafficking (X3);
- oFirearm related offences (x3);
- oPossession of a prohibited weapon; and
- oPossession of a weapon for a dangerous purpose (X2).

Thompson and Haubi were brought before a justice of the peace. Thompson was remanded into custody while Haubi was released on conditions. Both are to appear at the Alberta Court of Justice in Drayton Valley on April 15, 2025.

“The Drayton Valley RCMP un-

derstands that drug trafficking has been identified as a high priority within the community of Drayton Valley” said Cpl. Cam Turner, NCO/ic of the Drayton Valley RCMP GIS. “Drug traffickers exploit individuals with addictions leading to an increase in property crime and drug overdoses within our community. The Drayton Valley RCMP is committed to continuing to investigate and pursue drug traffickers that profit off and prey on vulnerable people with addictions within the community.”

that retailers will pass these tax savings on to Albertans in full.

“We do not want the re-

moval of the federal government’s consumer carbon tax to be a phony tax, so we will continue to use every tool at our disposal to ensure Alberta drivers are not

being gouged at the pumps. “We will be monitoring and reviewing pump prices for any wrongdoing, and take action if needed. Businesses found guilty of price

gouging can be fined by the courts up to \$300,000 or receive up to two years of jail time.”

## POWERING LIFE IN RURAL ALBERTA

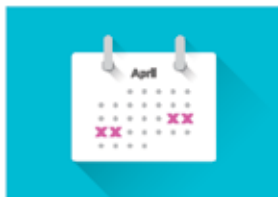

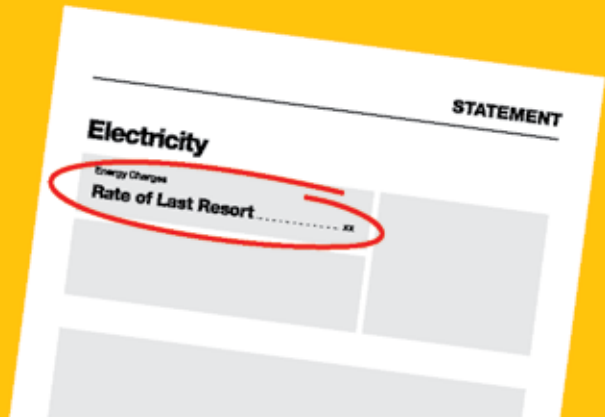

# Powering Life In Rural Alberta

A total of \$700,000 is allocated to the Rural Electric Program, recognizing the increasing role electricity plays in modern farming and ranching. Under this program, grants are administered by the Alberta Federation of Electrification Associations and support the construction of electrical services for farms and ranches.

“Alberta’s Rural Electric Grant Program is helping rural Albertans access the power they need to continue putting food on tables around the world. We’re grateful for the government’s ongoing support and commitment to rural electrification.”

When it comes to home

heating, Budget 2025 commits \$5.7 million to the Natural Gas Program, to be administered by the Federation of Alberta Gas Co-ops, to expand and update natural gas infrastructure. This funding will help provide more rural Albertans with reliable and affordable home heating options as well as help communities attract new businesses, create jobs and diversify the local economy.

For those who are unable to access the natural gas system, Budget 2025 also commits \$1.6 million for the Remote Area Heating Allowance program. Direct financial relief is provided to more than 2,000 households, the majority from Indigenous communities, to help with the high cost of alternative heating fuels, such as heating oil and pro-

pane.

“With this funding, gas co-operatives can continue the ongoing expansion of our natural gas distribution system so that we can connect even more rural communities to affordable gas heating.”

Equally as important as electricity and heat is access to safe, abundant water for residential, livestock and irrigation needs. Budget 2025 commits \$500,000 for the Rural Water Program, first introduced in 2024, to ensure rural water co-ops across the province have access to modern water treatment and distribution systems. Grants are administered by the Alberta Federation of Rural Water Co-operatives.

“Access to clean water is non-negotiable for any home or farming operation. The Rural Water Program is providing support as we work to ensure rural Albertans have the modern water distribution systems they need.”

# ALBERTA FINALIZING FLOOD MAPS AT LIGHTNING SPEED

Submitted by Government of Alberta

Alberta's has finalized more flood maps in the past five years than in the previous thirty-five years combined.

Flood maps help keep people safe and play a critical role in informing local emergency response plans and guiding future Indigenous community and municipal development decisions. In the past five years, flood mapping has launched in 100 municipalities and Indigenous communities.

Now, seven new flood map studies are underway for the communities of: Carbon, Chateh, Crowsnest Pass, Lethbridge Rycroft, Thorsby and Two Hills. Work will begin immedi-

ately, with results expected before the end of next year.

In addition, Alberta is soliciting feedback on four flood map studies nearing completion, including: Hinton, Vegreville, Stettler, Red Deer County and Marker-ville. Mapping from these studies covers about 250 kilometres of rivers and creeks through seven municipalities. Albertans can provide feedback at floods.alberta.ca until May 12.

All rivers, streams and lakes in Alberta have the potential to flood. Knowing where the water will flow during a flood is critical to understanding where it's safe to farm, safe to build, and how to best prepare for emergency situations.

"Our government is committed to creating more than 3,000 kilometres of

new and updated flood mapping by 2028. So far, we've completed 1,600 kilometres. This commitment has resulted in more flood maps being finalized in the past five years than in the previous thirty-five years combined. Alberta's proactive work will help protect communities, families and businesses in the decades to come."

# UPDATE ON MEASLES SITUATION IN ALBERTA

Submitted by Government of Alberta

Alberta's Chief Medical Officer of Health Dr. Mark Joffe issued the following statement on the measles situation in Alberta and how Albertans can protect themselves:

"Measles outbreaks are occurring in Canada, including Alberta. As of April 11, we have seen 58 confirmed cases in the province, and we are paying close attention to rising cases within the south and central zones. While the number of cases is concerning, I want to let Albertans know that public health officials are managing the cases and contacts as well as working with local leadership to support affected communities.

"As of April 11, an estimated

48 confirmed measles cases are likely to be past their period of communicability (the time the person can transmit measles to another person). However, it's important to note that this does not necessarily reflect risk in the community as there may be people with undiagnosed measles, including people coming into the province from other places where it's circulating, nor does it reflect the number of persons who have been exposed to measles.

"Measles is more serious than other common childhood illnesses. It can cause pneumonia, brain swelling and even death. Early symptoms of measles include a fever, cough, runny nose, red eyes and a blotchy red rash that appears three to seven days after the fever starts. If

you are showing symptoms of measles, stay home and call 811 for further direction.

"In light of the measles outbreaks across the province, I want to remind all Albertans that these outbreaks are highly preventable. Albertans can protect themselves and those around them by ensuring their measles immunizations are up to date. Immunization with measles-containing vaccine is the single most important public health intervention to prevent measles. This is especially true for parents of children aged two and younger, who are more susceptible to severe outcomes as a result of contracting measles.

"The measles vaccine is safe and highly effective at preventing infection and complications and is readily available to eligible Alber-

tans. To see if you are eligible to get the vaccine, for the Calgary or Edmonton Zone you can call the Immunization Booking Line at 811 between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. If you live in another zone in Alberta, contact your local public health or community health centre.

"Alberta Health is providing regular updates to measles cases at [alberta.ca/measles](http://alberta.ca/measles), including expanded data for age groupings, estimated data for those who are outside of their period of communicability and information related to immunization status of cases and number of immunization doses administered.

"It's important that Albertans do their part to prevent the spread of measles. For more information, please visit [alberta.ca/measles](http://alberta.ca/measles)."
