## WHITECOURT TOWN COUNCIL UPDATE

Submitted by Town of Whitecourt

Whitecourt Town Council has approved the 2025 Budget. The budget supports priorities identified by Council and its intention to sustain service levels, while ensuring the continued sustainability and growth of the community. A 3.53% tax rate increase is required to support the budget, this is a decrease from what was

originally proposed in the interim budget. Based on the approved budget, Administration is preparing the Tax Rate Bylaw which will be presented to Council at the April 28, 2025 Regular Meeting. The 2025 Budget Report will subsequently be published at the end of April and will be posted online at [www.whitecourt.ca](http://www.whitecourt.ca) and paper copies will be made available at the Town Office.

The 2025 Strategic Plan

has been adopted. The Plan identifies Council's key priorities and areas of focus for the remainder of the term. A copy of the Plan is available at [www.whitecourt.ca](http://www.whitecourt.ca).


Beyond the Legion, Edward has

Cash-out refinancing: With cash-out refinancing, a person will begin the mortgage process anew with the intention of paying off the current mortgage balance, and then taking out additional funds for other purposes. Cash-out refinancing is a way to tap into a home's existing equity for use on im-

provements or other expenses, such as college tuition.

2. Home equity line of credit: The financial experts at Bankrate in-

dicate that a HELOC works like a credit card, with the house as collateral. There is a credit limit, and borrowers can spend up to that limit.

The interest rate may or may not be fixed. However, the interest may be tax-deductible if the financing is used to

improve, buy or build a home.

3. Home equity loan: Individuals also can borrow against equity in their homes with a fixed interest rate through a home equity loan. Most lenders will calculate 80 percent of the home value and subtract a homeowner's mortgage balance to figure out how much can be borrowed, according to the financial advisory site The Simple Dollar.

4. Personal loan: Home-

owners can shop around at various financial institutions for competitive personal loans to be used for home improvement purposes. Funds may be approved within one business day, which can be ideal for those who want to begin their improvements soon.

5. Personal line of credit: A personal line of credit allows borrowers to borrow only the money needed at the time, and offers a variable interest rate that is generally lower than fixed loan

rates. Again, like a credit card, PLOC gives a person a maximum borrowing amount and is ideal for ongoing purchases.

6. Credit cards: In a pinch, credit cards can be used to finance improvements, but they do come with the cost of very high interest rates if the balance is not paid in full by the time the bill comes due. ## CREATE A TEEN-FRIENDLY SPACE AT HOME

## FIRE ADVISORY IN EFFECT

Existing Fire Permits will not be granted extensions while the Fire Advisory is in effect, and no new lighting of piles is allowed without prior approval.
