

- Turkey fryers,
- Tiki torches.

Allowed for use during the fire ban:

- CSA approved or ULC certified gas or propane barbeques used for cooking,
- CSA approved or ULC certified Wood Pellet Smokers.
- Propane and natural gas fire pits,
- Catalytic or infrared-style heaters,
- Electric or propane meat smokers.

The fire ban will remain in effect until conditions improve.

The operation of Off Highway Vehicles (OHV) within the Town of Whitecourt is prohibited under the Traffic Bylaw 1573 which prohibits OHV use within Town

boundaries between April 1 and November 30 annually. Penalties for contravening Bylaw 1573 range from monetary fines to OHV seizure



DIGITAL SPEED MONITOR RELOCATING TO WINKLEMAN BEACH TO ADDRESS SPEEDING CONCERNS

Lac Ste. Anne County Council has approved the relocation of one of the County's digital speed monitors from Range Road 31, north of Township Road 571, to the Winklaman Beach area. The move comes in response to resident concerns about excessive vehicle speeds along a key roadway in the community.

Over the past year, the County has taken several steps to improve road safety in Winkleman Beach. This includes reducing the posted speed limit from 50 km/h to 40 km/h to align with both resident expectations and speed limits in the adjoining jurisdiction, the County of Barrhead.

Despite this change, speeding concerns have persisted. In response, the County's Enforcement Services have increased patrols in the area and issued multiple violations. Relocating the digital speed sign is intended to further encourage compliance by making drivers more aware of their speeds in real time.

Although some residents have requested the installation of speed bumps, the County's Traffic Calming for Residential Areas Policy #04-040-016 does not support their use due to long-term mainténance and cost implications.

The relocated speed sign is expected to promote speed awareness and improve safety for residents and visitors in the Winkleman Beach area.
