### MAYERTHORPE RCMP RECEIVES A REPORT OF A MAN WALKING WITH A FIREARM

On June 10, 2025, around 5 p.m., Mayerthorpe RCMP received a report of a man walking with a firearm. Initial reports suggested there

may have been a shot fired but this has yet to be confirmed. Mayerthorpe RCMP, along with Alberta RCMP Police Dog Services and Alberta RCMP Remotely Piloted Aircraft System, responded to the call and

searched the area. A potential suspect fled the area on an ATV but a firearm was never seen or located.

It has come to the attention of the RCMP that a local emergency alert

### WHITECOURT FIRE BAN LIFTED

Due to recent precipitation, the Town of Whitecourt lifted the Fire Ban as of Friday, June 13. A Fire Ban was in place within Town limits since May 29, 2025 due to dry conditions.

Although the Fire Ban has been lifted, residents should remain dil-

igent and aware of potential fire risks. Residents are reminded that the Town of Whitecourt requires permits for all residential fire pits and temporary burning. For information on fire pit and burning permits visit [www.whitecourt.ca](http://www.whitecourt.ca).

The operation of Off Highway Vehicles (OHV) within the Town of Whitecourt is governed under the Traffic Bylaw, and OHV use within

Town boundaries is prohibited between April 1 and November 30 annually. Penalties for contravening Bylaw 1573 range from monetary fines to OHV seizure.



# Whitecourt RCMP Concludes Several Investigations And Arrests Prolific Offenders

Whitecourt RCMP General Investigation Section and Alberta RCMP Auto Theft North Division, executed a search warrant at the residence and shop linked to the driver. A plethora of tools were seized as well as several stolen vehicles, a side by side and a trailer.

As a result of the investigation, Joshua Carter (32), a resident of Whitecourt and a prolific offender in the area, was charged with Traffic Safety Act violations as well as the following Criminal Code offences:

- o Possession of property obtained by crime over \$5000;
- o Possession of property obtained by crime under \$5000 (x2);
- o Possession of property obtained by crime for the purpose of trafficking under \$5000;
- o Flight from police; and
- o Failure to comply with court orders (x2).

Carter was brought before a justice of the peace and released on

conditions. He is to appear before the Alberta Court of Justice in Whitecourt on June 24, 2025.

• On June 6, 2025, Whitecourt RCMP and Whitecourt General Investigation Section (GIS), located and arrested Chad Clark (32), a resident of Whitecourt, for outstanding warrants from both Whitecourt and Mayerthorpe, Alta. The combined warrants included a total of 20 Criminal Code charges from both areas. Clark is a prolific offender in both the Whitecourt and Mayerthorpe areas. Clark was brought before a justice of the peace and remanded into custody. He is to appear before the Alberta Court of Justice in Whitecourt on June 24, 2025.

• On June 6, 2025, Whitecourt RCMP received a complaint involving a suspicious vehicle driving down a dead-end road towards an oilfield lease site. Whitecourt RCMP members located the suspect vehicle, which proceeded to flee. The suspect, identified as Michael Bergeson (36), a resident of

Whitecourt, was later arrested and charged with two counts of Failure to comply with release order conditions. Bergeson was brought before a justice of the peace and remanded into custody. He is to appear before the Alberta Court of Justice in Whitecourt on June 24, 2025.

"I think it is important for us, your Whitecourt RCMP, to share

our successes and better communicate with you, our community" said S/Sgt. Matthew Clarke, Detachment Commander of the Whitecourt RCMP. "We want you to understand that we hear your concerns and are actively working towards making you feel safer within the community and making sure you have a voice when it comes to policing needs".

# ENOCH RCMP LOCATE STOLEN VEHICLE AND DRUGS WHILE RESPONDING TO A CALL

On June 4, 2025, at approximately 1:00AM while responding to a call for service on the Enoch First Nation RCMP observed a black Ford Flex with out of province plates parked along a tree line with two sleeping individuals inside.

Investigation determined that the two suspects had outstanding

warrants and the Ford Flex was stolen. Both suspects were arrested and during the course of the arrest one occupant resisted and was found to be in possession of drugs, cash and drug paraphernalia.

As a result of this investigation the following was located and seized:

- 32 grams of suspected cocaine;

- 18 unknown pills;
- drug paraphernalia;
- \$600 in Canadian currency.

Accordingly, Shaquina Papin-Alexis, a resident of Enoch, was charged with the following:

- Possession of stolen property exceeding \$5,000;
- Resist / Obstruct a Peace Officer;

- Possession of a controlled substance for the purpose of trafficking.

Papin was taken before a Justice of the Peace and remanded into custody, her next court date is scheduled for June 18, 2025 at Alberta Court of Justice in Stony Plain.

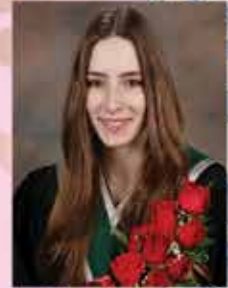

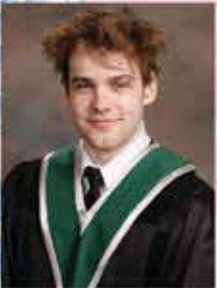

### EXPECT TO ENCOUNTER WEED INSPECTORS THIS SUMMER

[LSAC.ca/weeds](https://lsac.ca/weeds)

If you see County weed inspectors in your area, they are visiting every property to check for noxious weeds identified by the provincial Weed Control Act. If they find noxious weeds, a weed inspection report may be mailed to the landowner.

Under the provincial Weed Control Act, County weed inspectors have the appointed authority to enter any private property to monitor for noxious and prohibited noxious weeds and enforce compliance with the Act.

The purpose of this program is to educate and inform property owners about regulated weeds found on their land. In-person visits are conducted to provide the most effective guidance and support.

**Here's how it works:**

- 1. Initial Contact:** The inspector will attempt to contact you in person at your residence. This allows us to introduce ourselves and explain our process.
- 2. No Response:** If you are not home, they will leave a door knocker card with a date range for their return visit and contact information for any questions you may have and to book an inspection appointment.
- 3. Inspection:** On their return, the inspector may enter the property to check for noxious and prohibited noxious weeds. Inspectors will not go past closed gates or enter areas with livestock or crop without permission.

Please note, under the Weed Control Act, it is illegal to willfully obstruct or delay an inspector in their duties.

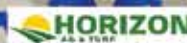

# WATER QUALITY ADVISORY ISSUED FOR ALLAN BEACH ON HUBBLES LAKE

Submitted by Alberta Health Services

Due to elevated levels of fecal bacteria currently present in the water at Allan Beach on Hubbles Lake, located within the Edmonton Zone of Alberta Health Services (AHS), AHS is advising

the public not to swim or wade at this beach area, effective immediately.

Elevated levels of fecal bacteria were detected via testing of the lake water at the Allan Beach location. At current levels, gastrointestinal illness may result from ingestion of the water at

Allan Beach on Hubbles Lake. As well, there is the possibility of skin, ear and eye infections with water contact.

As always, visitors and residents are reminded to never drink or cook with untreated water directly from any lake or reservoir, at any time.

Water-borne organisms, including fecal bacteria, can cause vomiting and diarrhea.

AHS Environmental Public Health officers will continue to monitor the water at Allan Beach on Hubbles Lake.

This advisory will remain in effect until further notice.
