had outstanding warrants and the Ford Flex was stolen. Both suspects were arrested and during the course of the arrest one occupant resisted and was found to be in possession of drugs, cash and drug paraphernalia.

- Possession of a controlled substance for the purpose of trafficking.

suspect driver exited the vehicle, entered a nearby truck and attempted to steal it. At this time RCMP officers were able to move in and arrest the suspect who resisted arrest.

The suspect was transported to a nearby hospital where he was assessed and

released back into the custody of the RCMP.

As a result of this investigation the suspect was identified as Colter Trynchy, a resident of Spruce Grove, who was charged with the following:

have been numerous sightings of Forest Tent Caterpillars throughout the province this spring. Forest Tent Caterpillar populations peak approximately every 10 years with outbreaks lasting from 2 to 5 years. While Yellowhead County has not yet seen the same numbers as other lo-

cations, the caterpillars are present in the area.

Forest Tent Caterpillars are easily identifiable by the blue stripes running the length of the body and a row of white, key-shaped markings down the back. The caterpillars often appear in large clusters. These clusters will feed

to a new location. While healthy trees can usually survive an infestation of Forest Tent Caterpillars, you may wish to remove them.

You can do so by scraping the caterpillars off of the tree, or use a strong jet of water to blast them off.

STUDENT LOANS ARE NOW ACCEPTING APPLICATION

Students can start applying for Alberta and Canada

student financial assistance for the 2025-26 academic year starting on June 2.

Alberta Student Aid is an effective tool to reduce fi-

nancial barriers to post-secondary education and helps students cover basic learning and living costs required for them to attend a

post-secondary institution. Students are encouraged to apply at least 60 days in advance of their study period start date.

"Alberta's government is committed to ensuring post-secondary education is accessible and affordable for those who wish to pursue it. In addition to the variety of bursaries, awards and scholarships available, student aid is an effective tool to help reduce financial barriers for students who are most impacted by rising costs."

Alberta students only need to submit one application to Alberta Student Aid and are assessed for both Canada and Alberta student grants and loans. Information, guidelines and requirements are available on the Alberta Student Aid website. Students can also access information about a wide range of student aid programs, including loans, grants, bursaries, awards, and scholarships – all of which can be used to support living costs.

Alberta's government has taken action to make post-secondary study more affordable by capping tuition increases, rejecting exceptional tuition increases, reducing interest rates on student loans and extending the interest-free grace period, increasing access to the Repayment Assistance Plan, and modernizing shelter allowances for student aid.
