

have been numerous sightings of Forest Tent Caterpillars throughout the province this spring. Forest Tent Caterpillar populations peak approximately every 10 years with outbreaks lasting from 2 to 5 years. While Yellowhead County has not yet seen the same numbers as other locations, the caterpillars are present in the area.

Forest Tent Caterpillars are easily identifiable by the blue stripes running the length of the body and a row of white, key-shaped markings down the back. The caterpillars often appear in large clusters. These clusters will feed
