As a result of these investigations, the following individuals were arrested:

- David Jason Masyk (43), a resident of Whitecourt, who was arrested on July 17, was charged with:

- o Possession of property obtained by crime over \$5000 (x2);
- o Possession of break-in tools; and
- o Failure to comply with release orders.

- Dustin Lee Curtis (35), a resident of Whitecourt, who was arrested on July 19, was charged with:

- o Break and enter (x4);
- o Theft of motor vehicle;
- o Possession of stolen property over \$5000 (x2)
- o Possession of stolen property over \$5000 - Trafficking; and
- o Failure to provide breath sample.

- Joshua David Carter (32), a resident of Whitecourt, who was arrested on July 16, was charged with 6 counts of failure to comply with various orders.

Masyk, Curtis and Carter were brought before a justice of the peace and remanded into custody. Carter and Masyk are to appear before the Alberta Court of Justice in Whitecourt on July 22, 2025, while Curtis will appear before the same court on Aug. 5, 2025. These and other files are still under investigation and additional charges may be considered once the investigations are complete.

"We understand that property crime is a big concern within the community" said S/Sgt Matthew Clarke of the Whitecourt RCMP. "We will keep working towards protecting your hard-earned goods from those who would seek to take them from you".

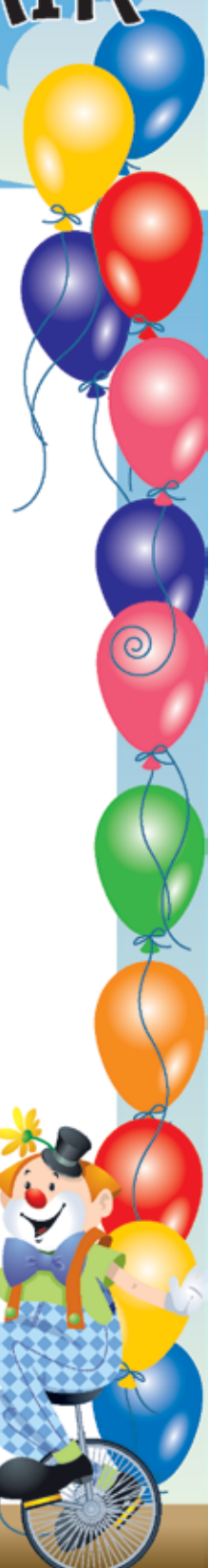
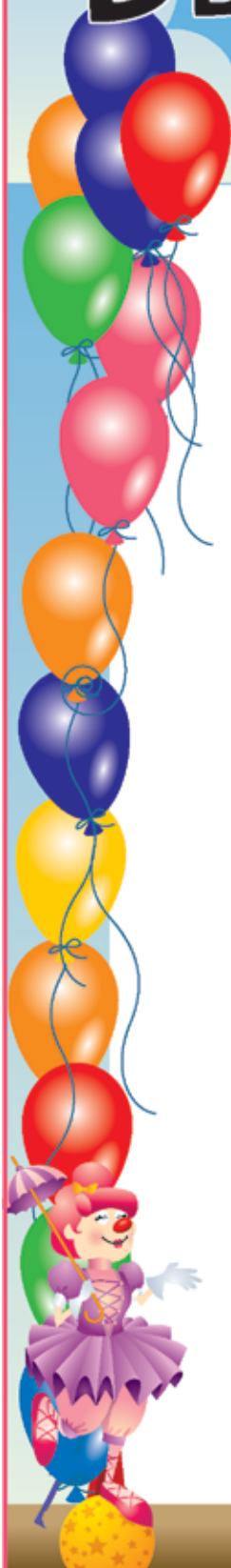

Schepp was brought before a Justice of the Peace and released with his next court date is scheduled for Aug. 13, 2025, at the Alberta Court of Justice in Stony Plain Alta.

As always, visitors and residents are reminded to never drink or cook with untreated water directly from any lake or reservoir, at any time. Water-borne organisms, including fecal bacteria, can cause vomiting and diarrhea.

AHS Environmental Public Health officers will continue to monitor the water at Alberta Beach.

This advisory will remain in effect until further notice.

# WHITECOURT TOWN COUNCIL UPDATE

Submitted by Town of Whitecourt

Whitecourt Town Council has awarded the Whitecourt Minor Ball Association with \$1,600 in funding from the Sports Hosting Program to host the 11UAA and 18UAA Baseball Alberta Provincial Championship July 25-27, 2025. The event will host 10 teams from across the province, with expected attendance of 204 players, coaching staff and managers, in addition to parents, friends, family and community spectators throughout the week-end.

Whitecourt Town Council has awarded \$1,000 as part of the 2025 Tourism Enhancement Grant to the Whitecourt Agricultural Society to host the 2025 RCMP Musical Ride on August 29, 2025.

Whitecourt has partnered with Northern Gateway Public Schools to host the Career Exposure Summer Camps, and contributed \$2,500 for both 2025 and 2026. The program provides a valuable opportunity for youth across the region to experience exposure to fields or technologies different from what might be offered through the normal school program, while earning school credits. The camps for 2025 were offered from June 30 to July 11, 2025. Information on the 2026 program will be posted next spring on [www.ngps.ca](http://www.ngps.ca).

MPE (a division of Englobe) has been awarded a \$112,000 plus GST contract to complete engineering services for the Flood Mitigation for Infrastructure Protection projects. The projects, which are funded under the Alberta Drought and Flood Protection Program (DFPP), will increase flood resiliency of critical infrastructure and include:

- Installing reinforced sheet piling to protect the raw water intake, construct an earthen berm to protect the site, and raise the gravel access road to the site;
- Raise Mill Road and install a culvert gate to protect access to the Water Treatment Plant and ambulance station;
- Construct a flood protective wall around the west Whitecourt

sewer lift station; and,

- Raise the 47 Street access to the natural gas station (golf course near tee box #15).

Tendering and construction of the above projects will be completed in 2026.

Whitecourt Town Council has awarded Whitecourt Work Wear Ltd. with \$10,000 in funding under the Vitalization Grant Program. The Program was established to assist property owners in the Downtown Core and along the Highway 43 Corridor to upgrade the façade of their building

to meet the stone and wood architectural theme of the Whitecourt Vitalization Plan.

The Whitecourt Quarterly Financial Report to the end of June 2025 is available to view on [www.whitecourt.ca](http://www.whitecourt.ca). The report identifies revenues and expenditures associated with providing municipal services, and provides highlights on areas of importance and successes.

A street closure has been approved for a car show, hosted by Ralcomm, on August 23. Reminders about the closure will be posted online closer to the event date.

A letter of support was authorized by Council for the Lac Ste. Anne Foundation to acquire provincially owned parcel of land in Whitecourt, subject to approval of a housing project.

# LAKEMERE 4-H BEEF CLUB CELEBRATES 75 YEARS OF “LEARNING TO DO BY DOING”

Founded in 1939, the Lakemere 4-H Beef Club is proud to be one of the oldest continuously operating 4-H clubs in Alberta. Since 4-H Alberta's beginnings in 1917, Lakemere has played a key role in developing rural youth through agriculture, leadership, and hands-on learning for over seven generations.

Today, Lakemere continues to thrive with a wide variety of project offerings. These include all beef projects, veterinary sciences, poultry, woodworking, fibre arts, and Cleavers (for members ages 6-8). The club's calendar is filled with activities focused on community engagement and “learning to do by doing”—the heart of the 4-H motto.

To mark this incredible milestone, the Lakemere 4-H Beef Club invites past and present members, families, and community supporters to join a 75th anniversary celebration, taking place September 5-7, 2025, at the historic Muir Lake Community Hall. Over the course of the weekend, guests can look forward to shared memories, honoured achievements, and new connections. Highlights include onsite camping, brunch, speakers, banquet, catered dinner, silent auction, and dance. The cost is \$35/person, and children 5 and under are free. History of Lakemere 4-H Beef Club

The Lakemere 4-H Beef Club has been an important part of the Stony Plain and Onoway communities for the past 75 years.

Stony Plain today is an extension of Edmonton, but in 1950, Stony Plain was “in the sticks.” North of town, many roads were little more than dirt trails. It was in this environment that a local farmer, Ben Huedepohl, felt there was a need to improve the quality of the beef cattle being raised in the area. In order to achieve this, Ben and his neighbor Jake Freitag set out to recruit some local young people. Eventually, they found enough interest to get started, and the Lakemere 4-H Beef Club was launched in 1939.

The area stretched from Spruce Grove to Onoway. Ben and Jake often drove the route, picking up the members to take them to club activities. In good weather, this was simply a matter of putting on a lot of miles. This practice of leaders providing bus services lasted for quite a few years. The club took its name from the school district in which several members and the Huedepohl family lived. Meetings were held in the Lakemere school. Since the club membership continued to come from a rather wide area, the location of meetings was changed, and meetings alternated between the Muir Lake and Heatherdown halls. Members' homes were also favoured meeting places off and on over the years, but the Muir Lake Community Hall has become the recognized headquarters for the club.

While the quality of the local cattle was one reason for starting the club, it is evident that Mr. Huedepohl's emphasis was also aimed at the improvement of the young people themselves. The first club trophy that he presented wasn't for the best calf but to the 4-Her who showed the most dedication, commitment, and proficiency in fulfilling the complete 4-H philosophy. After Mr. Huedepohl's untimely death in 1954, his family continued to present the efficiency award in his memory.

Achievement Day in the early years was a two-day event. The calves were first shown in Stony Plain (along with the Spruce Grove and White Rose clubs) at the rodeo grounds or in the skating rink in early July. Following the individual club and interclub shows, the

cattle were trucked to Edmonton. The next day, the club champions took part in the Edmonton region championships in the market steer class as well as in showmanship. For many 4-H members, a trip to Edmonton was a rare occurrence, and thus, achievement day was a highlight of the year. After Stony Plain built an ice arena as a centennial project in 1967, it was decided that it would make it a lot easier on the parents if achievement day could be cut back to a single day (especially during haying season). This was accomplished by holding a sale following the club and interclub competitions in Stony Plain. The clubs involved in the first sale at the Stony Plain arena were Duffield, Lakemere, Sundance, and White Rose. Shortly after the Sundance club folded, we were joined by the Twin Hearts club. Recently, the Stony Plain and District Achievement Day has been hosted by the Lakemere and Duffield clubs at the Stony Plain Heritage Pavilion on the second-to-last Wednesday in May. It marks the beginning of the Stony Plain Farmers Days celebrations.

Every club should have a uniform, and though the uniform of the Lakemere club has been modified several times over the years, blue jeans have remained standard. The first official uniform was a maroon coloured cardigan over a white shirt with a Lakemere crest on one sleeve and a 4-H crest on the other. The uniform was then modernized to a green fleece-lined sweatshirt and a white cowboy hat. Then it was decided that vests would look nice, and the mothers were persuaded to sew a bright green polyester version. After a few years, members chose to purchase blue denim style western style vests, and a new crest was designed to fit on

the back of the vest. This is still the logo used by the club. Today, the uniform is a long-sleeved, coloured green shirt with our logo, and of course, blue jeans.

The club went for many years with monthly meetings held on the first Thursday of the month. As members become more involved in outside activities, meeting dates

have moved. Currently, Lakemere meets on the first Wednesday of every month and hosts a reorganizational meeting on the second-to-last Wednesday of September for new members.

The Lakemere 4-H Beef Club is more than just a 4-H club. We like to think of it as a family. All club activities are almost always supported by parents as well as younger siblings. Currently, these younger siblings are enrolled in our very successful Cleaver program. Our 4-H families seem to enjoy each other's company genuinely, and club activities provide many hours of friendship, fellowship, and laughter.

With Jake Freitag's retirement, Ben Huedepohl's son, Chuck, took over as club leader. For most of his life, Chuck has stressed commitment in all areas of the club and encouraged all members to learn to do by doing. He was also heavily involved with 4-H on the district level for many years.

Over the years, many individuals have contributed significantly to the success of our club. Some honourable names include Charlie Parker Sr., Henry Goerz, Hans Strass, and Frank Radcliffe, who were all instrumental in providing our club with long-term leadership, guidance, and support to both members and parents. While these leaders are no longer actively involved in our club, they have left a great impact on our club. Today, we have a multitude of leaders who still carry on the legacy of being Lakemere volunteers. Without this kind of support, running a club would be very difficult.

The Lakemere Beef Club has always been proud of its accomplishments. Perhaps, the people involved in the Lakemere Beef Club can take their greatest satisfaction from the many people who have benefited from participating in the 4-H movement and who have represented the club with their heads to clearer thinking, their hearts to greater loyalty, their hands to larger service, and their health to better living for their club, their community, their country and their world.
