MORINVILLE RCMP OFFICER DRAGGED INVESTIGATING STOLEN VEHICLE

Submitted by Morinville RCMP

On July 29, 2025, at 12:30 a.m., an officer with Morinville RCMP Detachment conducted a traffic stop on a stolen vehicle parked at the Shell gas station in Gibbons. As the officer went to arrest the occupants, the driver started the vehicle and put it in reverse striking the officer who jumped into the moving vehicle to avoid injury. The officer was able to successfully disengage the vehicle from gear and pull the keys from the ignition as the

vehicle struck a tree. When the officer began to arrest the occupants, the driver pulled a shot gun out from between the seats, exited the vehicle, and threw it in the bed of the truck.

As search of person and the vehicle resulted in the seizure of:

- Small amounts of Methamphetamine;
- Small amounts of Fentanyl;
- A false bill of sale;
- The sawed off shot gun and ammunition.

The officer suffered minor injuries from the incident.

As a result of the investiga-

tion RCMP have charged the driver, Onoway resident, Ryan Calvin Grant (42), with:

- Possession of stolen property over \$5000;
- Possession of stolen property under \$5000;
- Weapons offences (x4);
- Drive a motor vehicle while prohibited (x2);
- Assault a police officer with a weapon;
- Fail to comply with a condition of an undertaking (x4);
- Possession of a controlled substance.

- Weapons offences (x4);

Nussey Racicot was taken before a Justice of the Peace and remanded into custody with her next court date for July 31, 2025, at the Alberta Court of Justice in Morinville.

"Everyday there are on av-

erage 2.2 acts of violence towards Alberta RCMP officers in the province. Since 2023, instances of assault on police with a weapon or causing bodily harm has increased 23%," says Darcy McGunigal Detachment Commander Morinville RCMP. "While we highlight dropping CSI crime rates and the most recent 18% drop

in stolen vehicles compared to last year, don't forget that with each of these arrests there are men and woman on the front lines putting their safety at risk combating these prolific offenders."

PRESENTATION ON CRIME PREVENTION STRATEGIES HELD JULY 30

Submitted by Town of Whitecourt and RCMP

On July 30, the Town of Whitecourt and Whitecourt RCMP partnered to host a community presentation on crime prevention.

The presentation, which was attended by approximately 50 business stakeholders and residents, provided information on tactics that are being used and recommended to reduce property crime.

"This presentation was hosted at the request of the Whitecourt Protective Services Committee, and I'm pleased with the level of engagement of those that attended the meeting," stated Whitecourt Mayor Tom Pickard. "Whitecourt Town Council is committed to enhancing community safety, and reducing crime is a priority – but it re-

quires a collective approach.

Increased implementation of CPTED principles, in coordination with the Habitual Offender Management Program, the Citizens on Patrol Program, and other Whitecourt RCMP crime reduction strategies, all work to address current community safety issues and reduce crime."

The presentation focused on Crime Prevention Through Environmental Design (CPTED) principles and how property owners can deter criminal activity by creating an environment that is less inviting to criminals. Suggestions included: installing motion lights to improve visibility, using fences and gates to secure areas, and maintaining landscaping for better sightlines. Further details on CPTED is available on our website.

A number of resources and

initiatives were mentioned during the presentation which are available on the Whitecourt website.

- RCMP Crime Map – This online feature enables the RCMP to share up-to-date information on criminal incidents.

Neighbourhood crime isn't just about numbers; it's about knowing where crime is happening in our community. This tool gives residents an opportunity to be an extra set of eyes and ears for the Whitecourt RCMP.

- CAPTURE Program - You can help protect your property, your family and your community by registering your security cameras with the CAPTURE Program. By registering your camera, you are taking an active role in deterring crime and assisting the Whitecourt RCMP with

its overall crime prevention goals in our community. This registry is completely voluntary and secure.

- RAVE Mobile Safety App - RAVE is a web-based communication platform that RCMP officers are mandated to fan out real time alerts to community members in Alberta. Users can set up their preferences to receive alerts via email, text message or phone, and alerts include BOLOs (Be On the Look Out), Crime Prevention tips, traffic advisories and general public safety messages.

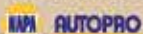

PARKLAND RCMP INVESTIGATING ASSAULT AT LOCAL DAY CARE CHARGES LAID

Parkland RCMP have laid charges in connection with allegations of assault from staff on children at the Little Stars Daycare in Spruce Grove.

As a result of the investigation, RCMP have charged 32-year-old Dimpy Bawa with;

- Assault with a weapon(x2);
- Assault(x2).

RCMP have charged 29-year-old Shivani Shivani with 2 counts of assault.

Both Bawa and Shivani has been released for court

on Sept 17, 2025, at the Alberta Court of Justice in Stony Plain.

RCMP advise that both Bawa and Shivani were released from the daycare at the onset of the investigation. The daycare itself has been cooperative with investigators.

BUILDING FOR THE FUTURE: MINISTER TURTON

Minister of Children and Family Services Searle Turton issued the following statement on the annual launch of a scholarship to help young adults formerly in care:

"To commemorate the Duke and Duchess of Cam-

bridge's royal visit to Alberta in July 2011, Alberta's government established the Duke and Duchess of Cambridge Scholarship. The scholarship recognizes the exceptional educational achievements of Advancing Futures students who have been in government care.

"We are investing in ad-

vancing the futures of young adults transitioning out of care by opening applications for the Duke and Duchess of Cambridge Scholarship until Aug. 31.

"It recognizes Advancing Futures students who have achieved exceptional grades while dealing with challenging circumstances. We will award \$2,000

scholarships to support the studies of 25 students in programs like arts, business, science and social work as well as diplomas in correctional services, esthetics, hospitality and paramedics.

"Through the Advancing Futures Program, the only program of its kind in Canada, Alberta's government invests \$14.2 million annually to support youth who have been in care by providing social and emotional transitional resources that assist them in accessing post-secondary education.

"Since Advancing Futures started in 2004, participants have experienced increased employability, higher earnings and increasing participation in the workforce, helping them transition to adulthood. They have enhanced life skills such as financial literacy and time management while experiencing an overall improvement in their well-being. So far, 1,575 young adults have graduated with a certificate, trade, diploma or degree.

"We remain committed to supporting young adults pursue post-secondary education and developing the employment and life skills they need to build meaningful careers and live independently. Alberta's government is committed to the well-being of children and youth who have been in our care."

CROP INSPECTIONS FOR CLUBROOT OF CANOLA COMING SOON!

Lac Ste. Anne County performs an annual inspection of all canola fields throughout the region, per Policy 02-010-003 Control of Clubroot Disease. This is done to monitor the pathogen's movement and reduce the spread throughout the County. In order to help producers make their own informed cropping decisions and reduce their risks, the County offers a map that shows where clubroot has been identified in canola. A copy of this map is available for viewing on our website.

Field staff will take all necessary bio-security precautions when entering a field for inspection including wearing disposable gloves and boot covers and sanitizing equipment between fields.

PROVINCE AWARDS \$935,000 IN GRANT FUNDING FOR TOWNSHIP ROAD 540 PROJECT

Lac Ste. Anne County, AB – Tuesday, August 5, 2025

The County is pleased to announce that it has been approved for funding through the Government of Alberta's Strategic Transportation Infrastructure Program (STIP) – Resource Road Program. The grant, totalling up to \$935,000, is designated to support the construction of an undeveloped segment of Township Road 540, between Range Roads 31 and 32.

"The STIP grant positions us to be ready—but not rushed," said Joe Blakeman, Reeve of Lac Ste. Anne County. "We appreciate the provincial government's recognition of our local infrastructure needs, and we're committed to ensuring we use it wisely."

The project is currently in the preliminary planning phase. The County is awaiting engineering assessments and rough cost estimates to better understand the scope and feasibility of the work. At this time, no construction timeline has been established.

Under the terms of the STIP grant, the province will reimburse up to 50% of eligible project costs, to a maximum of \$935,000. The final grant amount will be confirmed upon project completion and is subject to cost eligibility and budget compliance.

The County's General Manager of Infrastructure, Brian Hartman, added, "This section of road has long been identified as a strategic priority for improving access and long-term transportation efficiency. Our job now is to make sure the design, scope, and timing are right before moving forward."

The provincial government continues to invest in local and regional infrastructure to improve transportation networks, stimulate economic growth, and create jobs across the province. Lac Ste. Anne County would like to thank the Government of Alberta, Honourable Devin Dreeshen, Minister of Transportation and Economic Corridors, and MLA Shane Getson, Lac Ste. Anne – Parkland for their continued support of rural infrastructure.

**"Paratroopers Never Die,
They Just Drift Away"**



It is with profound sadness, yet also immense love and peace, that the family of Joseph Renaud Hammond shares news of his passing on July 31, 2025, at the age of 90. Renaud is survived by his cherished wife of 66 years, Fernande, and their children: daughters Diane (Richard), Johanne (Alvin), Linda (Ronald), Nancy (Travis), and son Steve. His legacy also lives on through his 9 precious grandchildren and 20 great-grandchildren, 7 sisters, 3 brothers, numerous cousins from the East, and a wide circle of friends. Renaud was predeceased by his parents, Alphonse and Ida, his sister Cecile, and many lifelong friends, including comrades from his army days. Born on April 12, 1935, as the eldest of twelve siblings on a family farm in St. Quentin, New Brunswick, Renaud's life was marked by adventure, hard work, resilience and an unyielding spirit.
